ORDINANCE NO. 1122(A)

An Ordinance amending City of Eunice Ordinance 2:81, “Salary of the Mayor”; increasing the salaried compensation of the elected officials of the City of Eunice to include the Mayor, Alderman at Large, Aldermen of four (4) city wards, and Chief of Police, subject to the provision of R.S. 33:404.1, in the following amounts:

WHEREAS, the Eunice Board of Aldermen announced at its regular meeting held on November 8, 2022, that a salary increase was being considered for elected City Officials, and;

WHEREAS, LA-R.S. 33:404.1 requires the increase in compensation of municipal officers, elected and appointed, be accomplished by ordinance;

WHEREAS, the total amount of increased compensation has been included in the 2022-2023 Annual Budget of the City of Eunice, adopted June 28, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the increase in annual compensation of the elected City Officials become effective January 1, 2023:
