

CITY OF SEGUIN

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN
ESTABLISHING THE LAWFUL SPEED LIMITS ON A PORTION OF STATE
HIGHWAY 123 WITHIN THE CITY OF SEGUIN; PROVIDING FOR
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY
CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR
PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION TO
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, in Seguin, Texas, an engineering and traffic investigation has been made to determine the maximum, reasonable and prudent speeds on the section of SH 123 from MP 10.596, at the Seguin city limit at Link Road, southerly to MR 23.947, at US 90 A for a total distance of 6.376 miles approximately; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the engineering and traffic investigation that the maximum, reasonable, and prudent speeds for the section of highway described above are as shown on the attached plans;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seguin as follows:

1. The maximum, reasonable, and prudent speed limits on the section of SH 123 from MP 10.596, at the Seguin city limit at Link Road, southerly to MR 23.947, at US 90 A for a total distance of 6.376 miles approximately are hereby declared and fixed as shown on the attached plans, labeled Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
3. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.
4. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
5. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.


6. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
