

**CITY OF FENTON, MICHIGAN
RESOLUTION TO ADOPT FEE SCHEDULE
UNDER CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE III OF THE FENTON CODE OF ORDINANCES**

Resolution No. 20-02

At a regular meeting of the Fenton City Council held in the Fenton City Hall, on the 10th day of February, 2020 at 7:30 p.m.,

PRESENT: Bottecelli, Grossmeyer, Jacob, Lockwood, McDermott, Osborn, Sage.

ABSENT: None.

The following resolution was offered by Sage and supported by McDermott:

WHEREAS, the City previously adopted Chapter 12, Article III of the Fenton Code of Ordinances to adopt the International Fire Code, 2012 edition (the “Code”) as the Fire Code of the City of Fenton, including all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, terms, and conditions provided therein to protect and safeguard the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Fenton; and

WHEREAS, Section 105.1.1 of the Code requires “[a]ny property owner or authorized agent who intends to conduct an operation or business, or install or modify systems and equipment which is regulated by th[e] [C]ode or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the fire code official and obtain the required permit;” and

WHEREAS, Section 105.2.2 of the Code authorizes the fire code official to “inspect the receptacles, vehicles, buildings, devices, premises, storage spaces, or areas to be used to determine compliance with” the Code prior to approval of a permit; and

WHEREAS, Sections 106.1 and 106.2 of the Code further authorizes the fire code official to conduct fire inspections of “any building, structure, marine vessel, vehicle or premises for the purpose of enforcing” the Code and “as deemed necessary to determine the extent of compliance with the provisions of the Code;” and

WHEREAS, Section 113 of the Code authorizes the City Council to adopt a fee schedule for permit fees;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Fenton to establish a fee schedule for fire inspections conducted under the Code to ensure initial and continuing compliance with the Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fenton, Michigan, as follows:

Section 1: Schedule of Fees. The City hereby adopts the following Schedule of Fees pursuant to Section 113 of the Code for periodic fire inspections:

**CITY OF FENTON
SCHEDULE OF FIRE INSPECTION FEES/CHARGES**

Periodic Business Fire Inspections

Periodic Fire Safety Inspections include an initial inspection and one re-inspection at no charge.

Non-Compliance Inspections include any inspection after the initial inspection and first re-inspection:

First Non-compliance inspection	\$50
Second Non-compliance inspection	\$75
Every additional Non-compliance inspection	\$150

Section 2: Validity and Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable and if any part is declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction it shall not affect the remainder of the Resolution which shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 3: Repeal. All prior resolutions and parts of prior resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby rescinded.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
