

ORDINANCE NO. 090325
0-09-45

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix A, Schedule of Fees, Rates and Charges by increasing fees and charges for Adult Performance Establishments, Escort Services, and Escort Licenses; Alcoholic Beverage bottle club licenses; Cable Franchises; Cemetery; Controlled Vehicular Parking Area Decals/Permits; Fire/Rescue false alarm, Prohibited devices, Fire alarm monitoring companies, Fire alarm system contractors and Fire inspections; Home Occupation Permits; Land Development Code petitions, applications, development services and zoning permits; Annual Spring Arts Festival permits; Burglar alarm operators, monitoring companies, systems, and systems contractors; Roam towing; Registered Domestic Partners; Secondhand Goods Dealers; Permits for use of and work in streets, sidewalks and other public places; Business tax receipt transfers; Traffic and Motor Vehicle parking violations and delinquency; Stormwater Management; Vehicles for Hire; and Vending booth and Itinerant food vendor permits; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing to be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Portions of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances, relating to fees, rates or charges for Adult Performance Establishments, Escort Services, and Escort Licenses; Alcoholic Beverage bottle club licenses; Cable Franchises; Cemetery; Controlled Vehicular Parking Area Decals/Permits; Fire/Rescue false alarm, Prohibited devices, Fire alarm monitoring companies,

1 Fire alarm system contractors and Fire inspections; Home Occupation Permits; Land
2 Development Code petitions, applications, development services and zoning permits; Annual
3 Spring Arts Festival permits; Burglar alarm operators, monitoring companies, systems, and
4 systems contractors; Roam towing; Registered Domestic Partners; Secondhand Goods Dealers;
5 Permits for use of and work in streets, sidewalks and other public places; Business tax receipt
6 transfers; Traffic and Motor Vehicle parking violations and delinquency; Stormwater
7 Management; Vehicles for Hire; and Vending booth and Itinerant food vendor permits, are
8 hereby amended to read as set forth below. The remaining portions of Appendix A remain
9 unchanged and in full force and effect.

10 (See Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by
11 reference as if fully set forth in full)

12 **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 shall
13 become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and
14 that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to
15 accomplish such intentions.

16 **Section 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the
17 application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding
18 shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect
19 without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of
20 this ordinance are declared severable.

21 **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such
22 conflict hereby repealed.

1 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption; provided however,
2 the fees, rates and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable to fees, rates and charges
3 which are due and payable after 12:01 A.M. on October 1, 2009.
