**ORDINANCE ENTITLED:** An Ordinance to amend Subsection 114-90(d) of the Gwinnett County Code of Ordinances addressing Sewer Construction Standards.

**READING AND ADOPTION:** November 4, 2014

At the regular meeting of the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners held in the Justice and Administration Center, Auditorium, 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia.

On motion of Commissioner Hunter, and seconded by Commissioner Heard, which carried 5-0, the Code of Ordinances of Gwinnett County is hereby amended by repealing Subsection 114-90(d) of Chapter 114 of the Gwinnett County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Authority" in its entirety and replacing it with a new Subsection 114-90(d) entitled "Authority."

**WHEREAS**, the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners adopted Sewer Construction Standards on November 16, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Gwinnett County to revise the Sewer Construction Standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gwinnett County Water and Sewerage Authority was established by local Act in 1970 to acquire, construct and equip water and sewerage facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gwinnett County Water and Sewerage Authority is well-suited to make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners regarding the creation of policies and practices that make the provision of water and sewerage services more effective and efficient; and

**WHEREAS**, this Amendment will provide for a more deliberative process regarding the formulation of revisions to the County's Sewer Construction Standards;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** that the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners hereby repeals Subsection 114-90(d) in its entirety and inserts the following language in lieu thereof:

"Subsection 114-90(d).

Authority. The Board of Commissioners hereby approves the existing Sanitary Sewer Installation Regulations and Specifications for Gwinnett County adopted by the Director of the Department of Water Resources on December 14, 2010, but no further proposed regulations and specifications enacted after that date. The Director of the Department of Water Resources shall deliver a certified copy of the existing Sanitary Sewer Installation Regulations and Specifications for Gwinnett County hereby adopted to the County Clerk for recording in the County's minutes. The Director of the Department of Water Resources may recommend future revisions to the Sanitary Sewer Installation Regulations and Specifications for Gwinnett County. All such recommendations shall be presented to the Gwinnett County Water and Sewerage Authority for review and recommendation prior to submission to the Board of Commissioners for

final action. The Board of Commissioners shall take action to approve, amend, or deny the recommendation. Any such revision shall specify its effective date."

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Amendment of the Gwinnett County Code of Ordinances shall be effective immediately upon adoption. Any actions taken by the Director of the Department of Water Resources to amend the Sanitary Sewer Installation Regulations and Specifications for Gwinnett County which have not become effective on or before the date of enactment of this Ordinance shall be ineffective and superseded by the provisions of this Ordinance.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances and regulations in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby rescinded to the extent of said conflict.
