AN ORDINANCE TO ADD DIVISION 4 AND SECTION 2.349 TO CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE CITY CLERK'S RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY CITY COUNCIL OF THE EXPIRATION OF CONTRACTS. □ □

THE CITY OF WARREN ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1.** That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warren, Michigan, is hereby amended by adding a section to be numbered 2-349 to Chapter 2, Article VI, Division 4,

**WHICH SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:**

**Sec. 2-349 – CITY CLERK'S RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY CITY COUNCIL OF CONTRACT EXPIRATION DATES**

In accordance with Section 7.11(5) of the City Charter, the City Clerk shall give ninety (90) days notice to the City Council prior to the expiration, renewal, or termination of any contract or agreement where the city or any city officer is a party.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect on June 9, 2021.
