

ORDINANCE NO. 80- 842

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 19.5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WARREN, MICHIGAN ENTITLED: MARIHUANA—MICHIGAN MEDICAL MARIHUANA ACT (MMMA) OPERATIONS, MICHIGAN REGULATION AND TAXATION OF MARIHUANA ACT (MRTMA) ESTABLISHMENTS, PERSONAL RECREATIONAL MARIHUANA ADULT-USE, AND MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITIES LICENSING ACT (MMFLA) FACILITIES

THE CITY OF WARREN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 19.5-15, Article IV of Chapter 19.5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warren, entitled, "Establishment/facility-specific regulations", at subsection (e)(1),

Shall be amended to read:

(e) Provisioning center facilities and retail establishments. In addition to the general requirements listed in section 19.5-11 and the security requirements listed in section 19.5-13, a provisioning center facility or a retail establishment shall comply with all of the following:

(1) Hours of operation. No operations shall occur (including performing home deliveries) between: 10:00 p.m. and 8:30 a.m. on Sunday through Thursday; and 12:00 Midnight and 8:30 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

SECTION 2. That Sec. 19.5-8 (1) of Article II of Chapter 19.5 of the Code of Ordinances relating to general conditions for patient and caregiver operations

Shall be amended to read:

Qualifying patients and primary caregivers may cultivate, process, transport, test, and transfer medical marihuana at patient operation or caregiver operation, if they comply with all of the following:

(1) General.

a. Submit a caregiver or patient operation registration form to the division of buildings and safety engineering.

b. Obtain written permission from the property owner before cultivating, processing, or using marihuana on the property.

c. Dispose of marihuana and marihuana-related byproducts in an opaque container, in an area not accessible to the public, and in a safe manner that does not clog any sewer system; contaminate the ground, air, or water; or otherwise endanger the public.

d. Obtain applicable city permissions, including, but not limited to: a medical marihuana facility certificate, certificate of occupancy, a city certification, site plan approval, and required variances.

SECTION 3. That Section 19.5-17, Article IV, Chapter 19.5 of the Codes of Ordinances of the City of Warren, entitled, Remedies and Penalties,

Shall be amended to read:

Section 19.5-17. Remedies and Penalties.

(a) If a person operates a Marihuana Business without a Municipal License, or a Caregiver Operation operates without a medical marihuana facility certificate, certificate of occupancy, or other permission, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.

(b) In addition to the licensing sanctions listed above, if a person fails to comply with the requirements listed in this Chapter, he/she/it is responsible for a municipal civil infraction punishable by a fine of \$500, costs not exceeding \$500, and other sanctions as provided by MCL 600.8727. Each day the violation continues is a separate offense.

(c) A Marihuana Business, Caregiver Operation, Patient Operation, or Personal Recreational Adult-Use operated without a Municipal License or not in compliance with the requirements listed in this Chapter is a nuisance and may be abated as provided in State law.

SECTION 4. Except for provisions amended by this ordinance, all other parts and provisions of Chapter 19.5 of the Code of Ordinances shall remain unchanged and in full effect.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect on June 9, 2026.
