#### **ORDINANCE NO.80-774**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD A DIVISION PROHIBITING OPERATING OPEN FLAME COOKING DEVICES IN RESIDENTIAL GARAGES OR OTHER ACCESSORY STRUCTURES

#### THE CITY OF WARREN ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1.** That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Warren, Michigan, is

hereby amended by adding Division 9 to Chapter 13, Article II

## WHICH SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

## **DIVISION 9. – OPEN FLAME COOKING DEVICES.**

## Sec. 13-95. Purpose.

It is the purpose of this Division to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City by prohibiting open-flame cooking devices in residential garages or other enclosed or partially enclosed accessory structures. Open-flame cooking devices used inside enclosed or partially enclosed accessory structures may start fires, cause explosions, or otherwise inflict physical injury or property damage.

#### Sec. 13-96. Definition.

As used in this Section:

Open-Flame Cooking Device. Any device that uses an open flame to prepare or cook food, including but not limited to charcoal and propane burners and grills.

Residential garage. A building or part of a building which is associated with a residential dwelling and, when constructed, was intended to be used to store motor vehicles. This includes garages that are attached to the residential dwelling and freestanding structures.

### Sec. 13-97. General Prohibition.

Except as provided in subsection 13-98 below, a person is prohibited from using an open-flame cooking device inside a residential garage or other enclosed or partially enclosed accessory structure.

#### Sec. 13-98. Exception.

An enclosed or partially enclosed accessory structure specifically intended for using an open-flame cooking device that has all required permits and permissions from the City for that use, is exempted from the general prohibition listed in Section 13-97.

# Sec. 13-99. Penalty.

A person violating this Division is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 and reasonable court costs of not more than \$1,000; imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days; or both.

Sec. 13-100. - 13-110. Reserved.

<u>Cross-references</u> – International Fire Code, Chapter 3, Section 308, Open Flames.

**SECTION 2**. This Ordinance shall take effect on March 20, 2019.
