ORDINANCE NO. 0-2023-004 1 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S LAND 4 **DEVELOPMENT CODE, CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE III, "DISTRICT** 5 **REGULATIONS," BY SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 24-41,** 6 ENTITLED "MASTER BUSINESS LIST," AND SECTION 24-266 7 **ENTITLED "DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (OP3D) USE** 8 9 LIST," TO PROHIBIT THE USE "MEDICAL MARIJUANA TREATMENT CENTER OR DISPENSING FACILITY" IN ALL 10 ZONING DISTRICTS BY INSTITUTING A BAN WITHIN THE 11 BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK IN 12 ACCORDANCE WITH **FLORIDA STATUTES** 13 381.986(11); PROVIDING FOR **CODIFICATION.** PROVIDING FOR 14 15 **SEVERABILITY;** PROVIDING FOR **CONFLICTS;** AND **PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 16 17 WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section (1)(f) of the Florida Constitution and Section 18 125.01, Florida Statutes, grant local municipalities broad home rule authority to adopt 19 ordinances to provide for health, safety, and welfare of the general public; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Park has adopted a local Code of Ordinances, 22 which serves as the regulatory document outlining the establishment and operation of land 23 uses within the municipality; and 24 25 **WHEREAS**, the City has duly established land development regulations contained 26 in the Land Development Code, Chapter 24 of the City of Oakland Park Code of 27 28 Ordinances; and 29 WHEREAS, on June 23, 2017, Governor Rick Scott signed Senate Bill 8-A, 30 substantially amending Section 381.986, Florida Statutes, allowing municipalities to either 31 ban Medical Marijuana Dispensaries or regulate them in the same manner as Pharmacies; 32 and 33 34 WHEREAS, in October 2017, the City Commission of the City of Oakland Park 35 adopted new legislation, amending the "Master Business List" table in Section 24-41 and 36 the "Downtown Mixed Use District Use Table" in Section 24-265 (later amended to 37 Section 24-266 entitled "Downtown Development District (OP3D) Use List") allowing 38 Medical Marijuana Dispensaries to operate in the City of Oakland Park consistent with the 39 40 same regulations governing pharmacies in accordance with Florida Statutes; and 41

WHEREAS, at the June 21, 2023, City Commission meeting, staff received feedback from the City Commission that Oakland Park has reached sufficient capacity for the location of Medical Marijuana uses and now desires to institute a ban on the establishment of new Medical Marijuana uses within the City in accordance with the authority provided under Section 381.986(11), Florida Statutes by prohibiting the use in every zoning district.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PARK, FLORIDA THAT:

11 <u>SECTION 1</u>. That the forgoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and 12 confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance upon 13 adoption thereof.

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15 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Chapter 24, Article III, Section 24-41 entitled "Master Business
16 List," of the City of Oakland Park Land Development Code is hereby amended as follows:

(C) Master business list. The following is the master business list, indicating the permitted
and prohibited uses and those uses subject to the supplemental regulations and
definitions of this section. The following uses are principal uses unless otherwise
stated. In some cases, a use may be permitted in the district, but would constitute a
change of use pursuant to the parking and landscaping sections of this Code. There
shall be no variances on the uses listed in the Master Business List in this subsection.

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26 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Chapter 24, Article XX, Section 24-266 entitled "Downtown
27 Development District (OP3D) Use List," of the City of Oakland Park Land Development
28 Code is hereby amended as follows:

(C) *OP3D Use List.* The following is the OP3D Use List, indicating the permitted and
prohibited uses and those uses subject to the supplemental regulations and definitions
of this section. The following uses are principal uses unless otherwise stated. There
shall be no variances on the uses listed in the use list in this subsection. A use listed in
the city-wide master business list in section 24-41 or not included in the definition or
description of a use listed herein but not listed in this table is prohibited.
