

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF INDIALANTIC,  
FLORIDA; RENAMING THE INDIALANTIC TOWN HALL TO  
THE PAUL R. GOUGELMAN INDIALANTIC TOWN HALL;  
AMENDING SECTION 1-2 DEFINITIONS; AMENDING  
SECTION 28-1(b)(2) NAMING FACILITIES; MAKING  
FINDINGS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, facility names may represent a physical location and/or a particular individual; and

WHEREAS, Section 28-1 of the Code of the Town of Indialantic (the “Code”) permits facility naming; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Indialantic desires to honor the memory of Paul R. Gougelman who served the community with extraordinary distinction as the Town Attorney and in other roles for more than thirty-five years;

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to change the name of the Indialantic Town Hall at 216 Fifth Avenue, Indialantic, Florida to the “Paul R. Gougelman Indialantic Town Hall”; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interest and spirit of the Town and its residents.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED** by the Town Council of the Town of Indialantic, Florida that:

**Section 1.**     **Recitals.** The above-stated recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2.**     **Facility Naming.** That Section 28-1(b)(2) of the Code is hereby amended as follows:

Facilities to be considered for naming or renaming may include streets, parks, dune crossovers, beach accesses, pavilions, piers, shelters, walkways and town hall.

**Section 3.**     **Naming.** That the Town Council hereby names Indialantic Town Hall at 216 Fifth Avenue, Indialantic, Florida the “Paul R. Gougelman Indialantic Town Hall.”

**Section 4.**     **Definition.** That Section 1-2 of the Code is hereby amended to include the following definition:

*Town Hall, town hall.* The terms “Town Hall” or “town hall” refers to the Paul R. Gougelman Indialantic Town Hall at 216 Fifth Avenue, Indialantic, Florida.


**Section 5.**     **Severability.** That the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

**Section 6.**     **Conflicts.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith, are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 7.**     **Effective Date.** That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption on second reading.
