

**ORDINANCE NO. 1919-07-22**

**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NACOGDOCHES, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 74 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NACOGDOCHES, TEXAS TO EXPAND THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Nacogdoches, Texas (the "City") owns and operates parks throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council met on July 8, 2022 to conduct City boards and commissions interviews and discussed the need to change the composition of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board; and,

**WHEREAS**, the current size of the Advisory Board was deemed to be too small and the number of applicants willing to serve was found to be ample, and,

**WHEREAS**, City Council determined that a larger Advisory Board would enhance the operations of the Parks Department,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NACOGDOCHES, TEXAS:**

**SECTION I**

All of the above recitals are found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings.

**SECTION II**

Sec. 74-27 of Chapter 74 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows, with any struck through text being deleted and any underlined text being inserted into the Code:

Sec. 74-27. - Composition.

The parks and recreation advisory board shall consist of not less than seven nor more than eleven adult citizens of the city.

**SECTION III**

All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof, that are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matter regulated.

**SECTION IV**

If any word, article, phrase, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such holding shall in no way affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

## SECTION V

All provisions of Chapter 74 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Nacogdoches not specifically amended or repealed herein remain in full force and effect. This ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City of Nacogdoches, and this ordinance shall not operate to repeal or affect any of such other ordinances except insofar as the provisions thereof might be inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, in which event such conflicting provisions, if any, in such other ordinance or ordinances are hereby repealed.

## SECTION VI

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

## SECTION VII

Proper Notice & Open Meeting. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

## SECTION VII

The City Secretary is hereby authorized and instructed to file a signed and sealed copy of this Ordinance in and among the records of the City of Nacogdoches.




