

ORDINANCE NO. 1536

AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER 11
CREATING A LAW PROHIBITING PUBLIC AFFRAY

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Alamogordo finds that the act of public affray is a potential harm to its citizens residing within the City limits;

WHEREAS, to this end, the City Commission desires to adopt an ordinance to deter violence amongst its residents in a public place, or where it disturbs others:

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to adopt an ordinance which is identical to the New Mexico rule 30-20-2;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court of the City of Alamogordo has jurisdiction over the proposed Ordinance and all petty misdemeanors committed within its limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Alamogordo that a new section be added to Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances as follows:

11-05-060 – Generally – Public Affray

Public affray consists of two or more persons voluntarily or by agreement engaging in any fight or using any blows or violence toward each other in an angry or quarrelsome manner in any public place, to the disturbance of others.
