

ORDINANCE NO. 1756

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE REGIONAL MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE AGREEMENT MADE AND ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLLEYVILLE, THE CITY OF KELLER, AND MUNICIPAL JUDGE SARA JANE DEL CARMEN ("JUDGE DEL CARMEN"). COLLEYVILLE, KELLER, AND JUDGE DEL CARMEN MAY COLLECTIVELY BE REFERRED TO AS THE PARTIES.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the Regional Municipal Court Judge Agreement dated September 17, 2014 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Municipal Judge Sara Jane Del Carmen has served well during her first year of service as Regional Municipal Court Judge; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Judge Sara Jane Del Carmen has brought innovation and leadership to the bench yielding improved operations and efficiencies in the Court; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to provide a one time, lump sum salary adjustment to Municipal Judge Sara Jane Del Carmen; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that the approval of this Amendment is in the mutual interests of the parties and is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, all matters stated hereinabove are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference as if copied in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, The Compensation and Evaluation Section is hereby amended with the addition of a new Section a.1. as follows:

In addition, the Regional Municipal Court Judge shall be paid a one time, lump sum salary adjustment in the amount of \$5,200.00 within thirty (30) days of the approval of

this Amendment. The cost of said one time, lump sum salary adjustment shall be split evenly between the City of Colleyville and the City of Keller.

Section 3: THAT, Based on the above and foregoing, the parties agree that these revisions shall be considered a part of the Agreement referred to above and incorporated by reference for all purposes. These revisions shall be subject to any and all other provisions of the Agreement, with the exception of the parts or provisions of the Agreement which have been revised by this Amendment.

Section 4: THAT, all other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
