ORDINANCE 2010-30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 98 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III. VEHICLES LICENSES, SECTION 98-84 FEES, AND APPENDIX D FEE SCHEDULE IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF NILES
