## **ORDINANCE NO. 7619**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31-51 AND 31-52 OF CHAPTER 31 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MANHATTAN, KANSAS RELATING TO THE PARKING, STANDING, AND STOPPING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN, KANSAS:**

**Section 1.** That Section 31-51 of Chapter 31 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Manhattan, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

### **Sec. 31-51. Limited time parking zones.**

- (a) In any 24-hour period, it is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on the same side of any street in the same block for a period or periods of time, the total of which is greater than the maximum period of time allowed by this section for parking on such block of such street. Parking, standing or stopping of a vehicle in any limited time parking zone shall only be allowed if such parking, standing or stopping is not in violation of any other provisions of the Code of Ordinances, City of Manhattan, Kansas and other applicable laws.
- (b) It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on any street in the locations specified in this subsection for longer than two hours, except that this limitation shall only apply Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

#### **Downtown District**

All streets within the area described as beginning at the intersection of the north right-of-way of Humboldt Street and the east right-of-way of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street; thence south along the east right-of-way of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to the south right-of-way of Houston Street; thence west along Houston Street to the east right-of-way of 4<sup>th</sup> Street; thence south to the south right-of-way of Pierre Street; thence west to the west right-of-way of 5<sup>th</sup> Street; thence north to the south right-of-way of Poyntz Avenue; thence west to the east right-of-way of 6<sup>th</sup> Street; thence north to the north right-of-way of Poyntz Avenue; thence east to the west right-of-way of 5<sup>th</sup> Street; thence north to the north right-of-way of Humboldt Street; thence east to the east right-of-way of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and the point of beginning.

- (c) It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on any street in the locations specified in this subsection for longer than two hours except that this limitation shall not apply on Sundays.

**5<sup>th</sup> Street**

The east and west sides of North 5<sup>th</sup> Street between Humboldt Street and the alley between Humboldt Street and Poyntz Avenue.

**Poyntz Avenue**

The north side of the 600 block of Poyntz Avenue.

- (d) It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on any street in the locations specified in this subsection for longer than 30 minutes.

**Humboldt Street**

The south side of Humboldt Street between a point 130 feet east of the east back-of-curb of the intersection of the south side of Humboldt Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Street and a point 160 feet west of the west back-of-curb of the intersection of the south side of Humboldt Street and 4<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Leavenworth Street**

The north and south sides of Leavenworth Street between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

- (e) It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on any street in the locations specified in this subsection for longer than 15 minutes, except that this limitation shall only apply on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**Poyntz Avenue**

The north side of Poyntz Avenue between a point 120 feet east of the east back-of-curb of the intersection of the north side of Poyntz Avenue and 8<sup>th</sup> Street and a point 285 feet east of said east back-of-curb of 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

- (f) It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on any street in the locations specified in this subsection for longer than two hours, except that this limitation shall only apply Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**10<sup>th</sup> Street**

Both sides of North 10<sup>th</sup> Street between Osage Street and Bluemont Street.

**12<sup>th</sup> Street**

The west side of North 12<sup>th</sup> Street between Laramie Street and Moro Street.

The east side of North 12<sup>th</sup> Street between Fremont Street and Moro Street.

**14<sup>th</sup> Street**

The east side of North 14<sup>th</sup> Street between Fremont Street and Laramie Street.

The west side of North 14<sup>th</sup> Street between Fairchild Avenue and Laramie Street.

#### **16<sup>th</sup> Street**

The east side of North 16<sup>th</sup> Street between Laramie Street and a point 110 feet south of the back-of-curb of the intersection of North 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Anderson Avenue.

#### **Central Park Road**

The west side of Central Park Road continuing to the north side of Central Park Road within City Park between Fremont Street and a point 210 feet east of the centerline of the intersection of North Park Road and Central Park Road, except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

#### **East Park Road**

Both sides of East Park Road at the northeast section connecting to 11<sup>th</sup> Street within City Park, except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

#### **Fairchild Avenue**

The north side of Fairchild Avenue between North 14<sup>th</sup> Street and North 16<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### **Fremont Street**

The south side of Fremont Street between North 14<sup>th</sup> Street and a point 200 feet west of the west back-of-curb of the intersection of Fremont Street and North 11<sup>th</sup> Street.

The south side of Fremont Street between North 10<sup>th</sup> Street and North 11<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### **Laramie Street**

The south side of Laramie Street between North 10<sup>th</sup> Street and North Manhattan Avenue.

The north side of Laramie Street between North 10<sup>th</sup> Street and a point 140 feet east of the east back-of-curb of the intersection of Laramie Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### **Moro Street**

Both sides of Moro Street between North 10<sup>th</sup> Street and North Manhattan Avenue.

#### **North Manhattan Avenue**

The east side of North Manhattan Avenue between Fremont Street and Bluemont Avenue.

### **Old Anderson Avenue**

Both sides of Old Anderson Avenue adjacent to the south side of Triangle Park between Anderson Avenue and North Manhattan Avenue.

### **Osage Street**

Both sides of Osage Street between North 10<sup>th</sup> Street and North 11<sup>th</sup> Street.

- (g) The City Manager is hereby authorized to designate on any street one parking stall for each of the locations specified in this subsection as limited time parking for no longer than 15 minutes. Once designated, signs shall be placed within each designated parking stall, clearly setting forth the 15-minute limitation that applies to the designated parking stall. Once signs have been posted, it shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit, or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood, or parked in the designated parking stall in violation of said posted sign.

### **Moro Street**

The north side of the 1100 block of Moro Street.

The south side of the 1100 block of Moro Street.

The north side of the 1200 block of Moro Street.

The south side of the 1200 block of Moro Street.

### **Poyntz Avenue**

The north side of the 300 block of Poyntz Avenue.

The south side of the 300 block of Poyntz Avenue.

The north side of the 400 block of Poyntz Avenue.

The south side of the 400 block of Poyntz Avenue.

The north side of the 500 block of Poyntz Avenue.

The south side of the 500 block of Poyntz Avenue.

**Section 2.** That Section 31-52 of Chapter 31 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Manhattan, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

### **Sec. 31-52. Limited time parking lots and no parking during designated times lots.**

- (a) It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on any parking lot owned by the city or other publicly owned parking lot within the city in the following locations in excess of the periods of time allowed for parking prescribed herein or during the periods of time prescribed herein when parking a vehicle is unlawful:

**The public parking lot south of the Library on the northeast corner of Juliette Avenue and Houston Street**

This entire lot will be designated as free parking with a three-hour time limit, except for the 11 stalls on the west side of said parking lot next to Juliette Avenue, which will have a 30-minute time limit. These parking time limits shall only be applicable on Monday through Saturday between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and on Sunday from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., provided that such restrictions shall not apply on any holidays.

**The public parking lot on the south side of Humboldt Street between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets**

Except as set forth hereinafter, this entire lot will be designated as free parking and the south two parking rows shall be restricted with a two-hour time limit. The time limits on this parking lot shall apply on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The city manager is hereby authorized to designate up to eight parking stalls within this public lot for reserved use by public vehicles only. Such public vehicles may be owned and operated by public law enforcement, community corrections, the United States Government, or any similar public agency or entity. Once designated, the city manager shall place signs within each such parking stall, clearly setting forth the public use to which such stall is reserved. Such stalls shall not be subject to the time restrictions set forth herein. Once posted, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in violation of the reservation noted thereon.

**The public parking lot on the north side of Houston Street, west of, and adjacent to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street**

This entire lot shall be designated as free parking with the north two parking rows restricted with a two-hour time limit. The time limits on this lot shall only be applicable on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**The public parking lot on the north side of the 1100 Block of Moro Street**

The entire lot shall be designated as free parking with a two-hour time limit. The time limits on this lot shall only apply on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**The public parking lot on the south and east sides of 227 Blue Earth Place**

The 34 parking stalls in the center aisle on the south side and eight parking stalls immediately east of the drive thru lane of 227 Blue Earth Place shall be designated as free parking with a two-hour time limit. The time limits on this lot shall only apply on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**The public parking lot adjacent to Town Center Mall**

The entire lot is designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Government vehicles, vehicles making deliveries to the stores located in Town Center Mall, vehicles used in

cleaning, snow removal or maintenance of the parking lot or Town Center Mall, or vehicles with lawful permits issued and displayed pursuant to section 31-70 of this Code are exempt from the 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. no parking restriction.

**The public parking lot at the Manhattan Municipal Court Building**

It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked on this parking lot between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. except for government vehicles and other vehicles authorized by the city.

**The public parking lots within City Park adjacent to North Park Road**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lot within City Park adjacent to Wefald Pavilion and the public parking lot within City Park adjacent to the City Park Activity Center**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking with a two-hour time limit, except that there shall be no parking between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lot within City Park on the south side of and adjacent to Wilson Field**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lots within City Park adjacent to East Park Road**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lots within City Park adjacent to Springboard Lane**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lots within City Park adjacent to the city pool**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lots within City Park adjacent to and southwest of Larry Norvell Band Shell**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

**The public parking lot within City Park adjacent to Baker Field**

These entire lots shall be designated as free parking, except that there shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and except where otherwise posted under the authority of the Director of Parks and Recreation Department.

- (b) The city engineer or his/her designee is hereby authorized to post stop signs, yield signs, signs and other markers denoting no parking areas, reduced speed zone signs and markers and such other traffic control devices at all locations as he/she may deem necessary and appropriate within the boundaries of any parking lot owned by the city or other publicly owned parking lot within the city. From and after the placement of such traffic control devices, it shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or owned or operated by such person to be stopped, stood or parked in violation of such posted traffic control devices and any violation thereof and the penalty therefore shall be as prescribed for such violation by the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, as adopted and amended by the city.

**Section 3.** Appropriate regulatory signs shall be erected to reflect the restrictions set forth herein.

**Section 4.** Section 1 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 7571 and all other Ordinances or portions thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 5.** This ordinance shall be published once in the official City newspaper and shall take effect on January 2, 2023.



## **ORDINANCE NO. 7619 SUMMARY**

On December 6, 2022, the City of Manhattan, Kansas adopted the following ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31-51 AND 31-52 OF CHAPTER 31 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MANHATTAN, KANSAS RELATING TO THE PARKING, STANDING, AND STOPPING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY.**

This ordinance amends portions of streets and parking lots from a three-hour limitation to two-hour limitation in and around the Aggieville district, except that the restriction will only apply Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The ordinance also applies the Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. exception to Downtown two-hour parking limits. The ordinance also removes parking limitations in the Laramie/12<sup>th</sup> Street parking lot that will no longer be a city-owned lot.
