

ORDINANCE NO. 3146

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MIDWEST CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 18, GARBAGE AND REFUSE, BY AMENDING ARTICLE II, MUNICIPAL COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE; SECTION 18-29, FEE FOR EXCESSIVE AMOUNTS OF GARBAGE, YARD WASTE AND BRUSH, AND LARGE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF THE CITY OF MIDWEST CITY, OKLAHOMA:

ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. The Midwest City Municipal Code, Chapter 18, Garbage and Refuse, Article II, Municipal Collection and Disposal Service, Section 18-29, Fee for excessive amounts of garbage, yard waste and brush, and large household items, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-29 Fee for excessive amounts of garbage, trash, yard waste and brush, and large household items

Upon customer request, a special pickup for excessive amounts of brush and large, bulky household items can be arranged. Brush will be limited to sizes that can be handled by one person. Household furniture and other bulky items can be picked up at the curb. Household appliances are not eligible to be included in special pickups. Special pickups will be scheduled for Wednesdays and requests must be made before 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday. The following fees will be charged for special pickups:

Residential customers: \$35.00 per half hour (minimum of one-half hour)

Neighborhood Association clean-ups \$50.00 per hour (minimum charge of \$50.00)

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the 14th day of July, 2011.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.
