

### An Ordinance to Establish Parking Offense Schedule of Fines

Sponsored by: Mayor William S. Stimpson

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOBILE, ALABAMA that Section 61 of the Mobile City Code-Traffic be amended to establish and add parking fines, pursuant to Ala. Code Sec. 11-45-9 (1975) and Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration 19 (B).

61-261 Standing or parking close to curb	\$30
61-262 Signs or markings indicating angle parking; obedience to signs	\$50
61-263 Parking not to obstruct traffic	\$30
61-264 Parking prohibited on narrow streets	\$30
61-265 Parking in alleys	\$30
61-266 Parking for more than seven days; leaving damaged or wrecked vehicle for more than six hours	\$50
61-267 (a) parking in a handicapped zone without a handicap sign	\$130
61-268 Parking on private premises after warning	\$70
61-269 Fire lanes	\$70
61-270 Parking adjacent to schools	\$50
61-271 Parking for display of goods, etc., prohibited in certain areas	\$30
61-272 Parking to sell produce, etc.	\$50
61-273 Stopping, standing or parking prohibited; when signs not required	\$30
61- 274 No stopping, standing or parking near hazardous or congested places	\$30
61-275 Parking, stopping or standing on ROW, median strip or planting strips	\$70

61-276 Standing or parking on one-way streets and roadways	\$30
61-277 Dealers, etc., parking or storing vehicles on streets	\$50
61-278 Large vehicles (eg., parked in residential areas)	\$70
61-279 Vehicles not to use more than one parking space	\$15
61-280 Stopping, standing or parking restricted or prohibited on certain streets	\$50
61-281 Parking cutbacks	\$15
61-282 Transferring goods, etc., from one vehicle to another	\$30
61-283 Permits for loading at an angle to the curb	\$50
61-298 Overtime parking	\$10
61-313 Passenger curb loading zones	\$30
61-314 Freight curb loading zones	\$30
61-316 Bus and taxicab stands	\$30
61-317 Restricted use of bus and taxicab stands	\$30

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law. This ordinance applies to parking within the city limits and police jurisdiction of the City of Mobile and shall be in full force and effect therein.
