AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EXISTING MECHANICAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PEACHTREE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Peachtree City, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same, that Article IV. Mechanical - Section 5-40. Codes adopted; be amended to read as follows:

Section 5-40. Code adopted; penalty for violation.

There is hereby adopted by the city, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the installation, alteration, removal, use, location and maintenance of heating, air conditioning and other mechanical equipment and systems in buildings and structures, including permits, that certain mechanical code known as the Standard Mechanical Code, 1982 edition, promulgated by the Southern Building Code Congress, Birmingham, Alabama, and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as are in conflict with this Code of Ordinances, or are hereinafter deleted, modified or amended, of which a copy has and now is filed in the office of the building official, and this 1982 edition, all future editions and supplements of the Standard Mechanical Code are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, with the above exceptions, and the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the city.

Any person violating any provision of such codes shall be punished as provided in section 1-8 of this Code of Ordinances.

All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in their entirety. Ordinances effective the _____.
