

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF  
DEFACING SIGNS, BUILDINGS  
TO DEFINE SAID OFFENSE; TO PRESCRIBE  
THE PENALTY THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Peachtree City, and  
it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Defacing Signs, Buildings ....It shall be unlawful  
for any person to paste or glue, or fix in any  
manner any cardboard or paper advertisement on  
any sign or building within the city without per-  
mission of the owner or the city; or to deface  
the street or public signs within the city by  
paint, crayon marks, or otherwise.

Section 2. Penalty: Any person violating the within ordinance  
of Peachtree City shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$200.00  
for each offense; to imprisonment for a period of not more than  
sixty (60) days for each offense, or at labor on the road and  
streets or other public works of the city, for not more than  
sixty (60) days for each offense, any one or more of these  
punishments, when the facts of the case shall so justify.
