AN ORDINANCE

presents the following ordinance:

Amending Title 5, Chapter 109 Article I of
the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to
Building Code; Signs and Billboards

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 109 of the above entitled ordinance be amended by
adding a new section 109.60 reading as follows:

Section 109.60 Political campaign signs. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER
PROVISION OF THIS CODE TO THE CONTRARY, NO LICENSE OR PERMIT SHALL
BE REQUIRED FOR THE PLACING OF TEMPORARY POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS
NOT MORE THAN 32 SQ. FT. IN AREA WHERE THE PLACING OF SUCH SIGNS IS
AUTHORIZED BY THE ZONING ORDINANCE. LAWN SIGNS SHALL BE REMOVED
SIX DAYS AFTER A GENERAL ELECTION.


