Alderman Scallon

presents the following ordinance:

Amending Title 13, Chapter 341 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Licenses and Business Regulations: Taxicabs.

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 341.730 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances be amended to read as follows:

341.730. Group Loading. In each load of five (5) passengers or less a separate fare may be charged for each of such passengers, providing that such group does not have a common destination and provided further that no other cab is available at the point of loading and no delay is caused to any waiting passenger. Any waiting passenger may command the cab's immediate departure, and no such passenger shall be required to pay for any more circuitous route than the shortest distance between the point of loading and such passenger's destination. THE RATE OF FARE SHALL BE EIGHTY PERCENT (80%) OF THE BASE LEGAL RATE, SAID DISCOUNT TO BE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER DISCOUNT AUTHORIZED BY THIS CODE AND OFFERED BY THE CARRIER. A concise but legible notice of the provisions of sections 341.720 and 341.730 shall be clearly displayed in the cab so it may be easily read by any passenger.




