AN ORDINANCE of the CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS

Cramer

presents the following ordinance:

Amending Title 19, Chapter 509 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinance relating to Water, Sewers and Sewage Disposal: Water, Art. IV Rates and Charges.

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 509.630 of the above entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

509.630. Meter rates established. Effective January 1, 1983, the meter rates for water are hereby fixed and shall be collected as follows:

(a) Eighty cents (\$0.80) per one hundred (100) cubic feet for consumers, otherwise mentioned, within the limits of the City of Minneapolis.

(b) Eighty cents (\$0.80) per one hundred (100) cubic feet of the United States Government within the city limits, and outside or adjacent to the city limits, such rates and upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the city and the United States Government.

(c) Eighty cents (\$0.80) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to the University of Minnesota, the United States Veterans' Hospital, the metropolitan airports commission for service to Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport, and all city-owned property.

(d) Eighty-nine cents (\$0.89) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to municipalities and villages outside the corporate limits of the city where service to such municipalities or villages is given through a master meter.

(e) Ninety-four cents (\$0.94) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to municipalities, municipal corporations, villages and consumers outside the corporate limits of the city where service is furnished through individual consumer meters.

(f) Rates for municipalities, municipal corporations and villages, which are established by contract, shall continue on the existing contract basis with the exception of the Village of Hilltop which shall be treated as a municipality outside the corporate limits of the city whose service is given through a master meter.

Effective January 1, 1984 1992, the meter rates for water are hereby fixed and shall be collected as follows:

(a) Eighty-five cents (\$0.85) ONE DOLLAR TEN CENTS (\$1.10) per one hundred (100) cubic feet for consumers not otherwise mentioned, within the limits of the City of Minneapolis.

(b) Eight-five cents (\$0.85) ONE DOLLAR TEN CENTS (\$1.10) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to the United States Government within the city limits, and outside of or adjacent to the city limits, such rates and upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the city and the United States Government.

(c) ~~Eighty-five cents (\$0.85)~~ ONE DOLLAR TEN CENTS (\$1.10) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to the University of Minnesota, the United States Veterans' Hospital, the metropolitan airports commission for service to Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport, and all city-owned property.

(d) ~~Ninety-four cents (\$0.94)~~ ONE DOLLAR NINETEEN CENTS (\$1.19) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to municipalities and villages outside the corporate limits of the city where service to such municipalities or villages is given through a master meter.


(e) One dollar ~~TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$1.00)~~ (\$1.25) per one hundred (100) cubic feet to municipalities, municipal corporations, villages and consumers outside the corporate limits of the city where service is furnished through individual consumer meters.


(f) Rates for municipalities, municipal corporations and villages, which are established by contract, shall continue on the existing contract basis with the exception of the Village of Hilltop which shall be treated as a municipality outside the corporate limits of the city whose service is given through a master meter.
