

ORDINANCE 2020-07

AN ORDINANCE UPDATING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 10 “SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN STREETS”, ARTICLE I ENTITLED “IN GENERAL” SECTION 10-5 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WARRENTON

WHEREAS, the Town of Warrenton Town Code contains Sec. 10-5 designating certain streets with specific speed limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Warrenton has reviewed and recommended to authorize the Town Manager to regulate the speed limits within the Town of Warrenton pursuant to Virginia Code §46.2-1300 and authorize all other powers under said Virginia Code to the Town Manager; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 10-5 has a list of speed limits for certain streets; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Warrenton directs that those speed limits and all others under the Town of Warrenton jurisdictional authority remain the same unless or until the Town Manager exercises her authority to change them; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed, recommended approval this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council for the Town of Warrenton, Virginia this 10th day of November 2020, that Chapter 10, “Speed Limits on Certain Streets”, Article I entitled “In General”, Section 10-5,(b),of the Code for the Town of Warrenton be, and it hereby is, amended and adopted to read in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 10-5. - Speed limits on streets and authority to change speed limits within the Town’s jurisdiction:

Pursuant to Virginia Code §46.2-1300 the Town Council of the Town of Warrenton does hereby authorize the Town Manager to hold any and all authority thereunder in accordance therewith not to exceed the powers granted thereunder. All signs regulating speeding, or any other traffic signs, currently erected as of November 1, 2020 shall be in full force and effect until the Town Manager changes said signs thereafter. All penalties associated therewith shall be in effect as permissible by state or town code or any associated state statute or town code and are incorporated herein. All authority granted under by state code shall also remain in full force and effect, specifically Virginia Code §46.2-874, §46.2-875, and §46.2-878 as amended.


