

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-78

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 2.172 OF THE SAN MARCOS CITY CODE TO CHANGE THE MEMNBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE ON THE PARKING ADVISORY BOARD; INCLUDING PROCEDURAL PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

1. Section 2.172 of the San Marcos City Code defines the membership requirements for the Parking Advisory Board.
2. The revision of the membership requirements Parking Advisory Board will assist and meet the requirement in appointing individuals who represent a variety of City of San Marcos stakeholders

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2.172 of the San Marcos City Code is hereby amended to read as follows. Added provisions are indicated by underlining. Deleted provisions are indicated by strikethroughs.

Sec. 2.172. Composition; appointment of members.

The board will be comprised of seven voting members, and two non-voting city council members. The city council shall appoint all members of the board. When considering appointments to the board, the city council shall endeavor to appoint individuals who represent the variety of downtown stakeholders, and who meet the following qualifications: One member recommended by the Main Street Advisory Board, one member recommended by the Downtown Association of San Marcos Board, ~~one member who is~~ two members who are either a business owner within the Downtown Parking Benefit District, ~~one member who is~~ a property owner within the Downtown Parking Benefit District, ~~one member who is~~ or a resident within the Downtown Parking Benefit District, ~~two~~ three members at-large, and two non-voting city council members.

SECTION 3. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in effect upon adoption on second reading.

PASSED AND APPROVED on first reading on October 2, 2023.


