

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-36

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN MARCOS, TEXAS, INCREASING RATES ESTABLISHED
FOR WATER, WHOLESALE WATER, RECLAIMED WATER,
WASTEWATER TREATMENT, AND SEWER SURCHARGES;
AND INCLUDING PROCEDURAL PROVISIONS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS,
TEXAS:**

SECTION 1. The City of San Marcos rates for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2015 and ending on September 30, 2016 for water, wholesale water, reclaimed water, wastewater treatment, and sewer surcharges as shown on the attached Exhibit A, which is made a part of this ordinance for all purposes, are hereby approved.


SECTION 2. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and resolution or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance will take effect ten days after the date of its final passage, and it will apply to all utility bills issued on and after October 1, 2015. The City Clerk will publish notice of its adoption in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.
