## SPALDING COUNTY, GEORGIA ORDINANCE NO. 2019-ORD-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF SPALDING COUNTY. GEORGIA, PART VI, CHAPTER 9, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR CANVASSING, PEDDLING AND DOOR TO DOOR SALES, SECTION 6-9002(7) FINGERPRINTING (e) BY DELETING THE SECOND SENTENCE OF SAID PARAGRAPH IN ITS ENTIRETY.

Section 6-9002 Door to door canvassing, and soliciting prohibited; exceptions:

(7) Fingerprinting

(e) If an employer or organization is a private entity, the Spalding County Sheriff's Office shall render a fitness determination based upon the results of the criminal background check and communicate its fitness determination to such private employer or organization. If an employer or organization is a public entity, the Spalding County Sheriff's Office shall (1) render a fitness determination based upon the results of the criminal background check and communicate its fitness determination to such public entity or (2) disseminate the results of the criminal background check to the public entity for a fitness determination
