

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-971

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WACO, TEXAS, ADDING THE HONORARY NAME OF PET CIRCLE ROAD TO A PORTION OF CIRCLE ROAD IN THE CITY OF WACO, MCLENNAN COUNTY, TEXAS, FROM THE CIRCLE ROAD INTERSECTION WITH LA SALLE AVENUE AT THE CIRCLE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHBOUND JACK KULTGEN EXPRESSWAY; AUTHORIZING CHANGING THE CITY PLAN TO INCLUDE THE HONORARY NAME; AUTHORIZING CHANGING THE CITY OF WACO MAPS; PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL STREET SIGNS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2024, the Waco City Plan Commission conducted a public hearing on this matter and recommended that the honorary name of Pet Circle Road be added to a portion of **Circle Road in the City of Waco, McLennan County, Texas, from the Circle Road intersection with La Salle Avenue at The Circle to the intersection with the northbound Jack Kultgen Expressway**; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2024, the City Council held a public hearing concerning this proposed honorary street name,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WACO, TEXAS:

Section 1. That all of the recitals and preambles hereinabove stated are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. That the honorary street name of Pet Circle Road be added to a portion of **Circle Road in the City of Waco, McLennan County, Texas, from the Circle Road intersection with La Salle Avenue at The Circle to the intersection with the northbound Jack Kultgen Expressway**, as shown on the map attached as **Exhibit “A”**.

Section 3. That staff is hereby authorized to change the City Plan to include the honorary name of the street.

Section 4. That the City of Waco maps are to be changed to include the honorary name of the street.

Section 5. That Traffic Services is hereby instructed to provide additional street signs to indicate the honorary name as set out above.

Section 6. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be severable and that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance and the remainder of such ordinance shall

continue in full force and effect the same as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision had never been a part hereof.

Section 7. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
