## A RESOLUTION APPROVING 2025 DONATION REQUEST BY JOHNSON COUNTY CANCER FOUNDATION FROM THE STEVENSON FUND

WHEREAS, the Stevenson Fund was formally established by the City of Warrensburg, and codified at Section 2-541 et seq. in the Code of Ordinances resulting from a bequest by Charles W. Stevenson under his Last Will & Testament dated 1928; and

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the Warrensburg City Council serves as committee and trustees of the trust fund and shall administer the said trust funds as provided by the Last Will & Testament, and shall add one-tenth of the annual income therefrom to the principal each year, and after all the expenses of administering the fund for each year are paid, shall pay the net balance of the income for such year into the city treasury for appropriation by the city council for the objects and purposes provided in the Last Will & Testament; and

**WHEREAS**, the Last Will & Testament provides the funds are to be used for charitable, educational or library purposes; and

WHEREAS, a 2025 donation request has been received from the Johnson County Cancer Foundation (JCCF). The JCCF was established in 2006 and created as a non-profit 501c3 tax exempt organization. The purpose is to provide monetary assistance to Johnson County residents who may need support coping with the toll of battling cancer. JCCF is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors consisting of nineteen individuals from throughout the county. JCCF's funding comes from a variety of sources, including a golf tournament, run/walks, sponsors, memorials, and other organization's' fund raisers; and

**WHEREAS**, to date, the JCCF has donated just over \$1,212,500 in total giving helping over 700 families receiving assistance.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARRENSBURG, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City of Warrensburg City Council approves a donation request by the Johnson County Cancer Foundation in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) to provide monetary assistance to Johnson County residents who may need support coping with the toll of battling cancer.
