

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF WINDER,
GEORGIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 15 OF THE CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR
OBEDIENCE TO ORDERS OR DIRECTIONS, ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS, TO
PROHIBIT PASSING EMERGENCY VEHICLES, TO PROHIBIT CROSSING A FIRE
HOSE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF CERTAIN STREETS BY
CERTAIN VEHICLES, TO PROVIDE FOR DELIVERY TIMES, TO PROVIDE FOR
PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

It is hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of Winder, Georgia that the City Code of Ordinances of the City of Winder, Georgia is hereby amended as follows:

Section I. Section 15-5 of the City Code is hereby deleted and a new Section is inserted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

Section 15-5. Obedience to orders or directions. No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order or direction of a police officer, member of the fire department, or other city workers given for the purpose of regulating traffic.

Section II. Section 15-7 of the City Code is hereby deleted and a new Section 15-7 is inserted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

Section 15-7. Enforcement. It shall be the duty of the city police department to enforce the provisions of this Chapter. Officers of the police department are authorized to direct all traffic, either in person or by means of a visible or audible signal, in conformity with the provisions of this Chapter; provided that, upon fire or other emergency, or to expedite traffic or to safeguard pedestrians, officers of the police or fire department or any other department of the City may direct traffic, as conditions may require.

Section III. Section 15-8 of the City Code of is hereby deleted and a new Section 15-8 is inserted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

Section 15-8. Passing emergency vehicle. No person driving a vehicle shall pass any fire truck operating emergency lights or apparatus while same is proceeding to an emergency response, nor shall any such person pass an ambulance while the same is being used to answer an emergency response.

Section IV. Section 15-9 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "parading or" from said Section.

Section V. Section 15-10 of the City Code is hereby deleted and a new Section 15-10 is inserted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

Section 15-10. Regulation of use of streets by certain vehicles.

- (a) The following streets in the City shall not be used by motor vehicles with more than two axles except that such vehicles may be used on such streets to make deliveries, pick-ups or otherwise transact business at a location on such streets:

- (b) If a delivery or pickup is to be made by a truck with more than two axles, upon any street designated in this section; such delivery or pickup shall be made between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Section VI. The City Code of the City of Windier is hereby amended by adopting a new Section 15-11 to read as follows:

Section 15-11. Parental responsibility. It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian, conservator or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of 16 years to permit, whether knowingly or through ineffective control or supervision, such minor to violate any provision of this Code or state law regarding the operation of vehicles.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

It is so ordained this 10th day of November, 2015.
