

ORDINANCE NO. 877

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING, REPEALING, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING VARIOUS SECTIONS IN CHAPTER 2 OF THE WORLAND CITY CODE PERTAINING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF CITY BUSINESS. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING.

SECTION 1: Section 2-1(A) of the Worland City Code shall be amended as follows, to-wit (Amendments in **BOLD**):

A. The Mayor shall appoint, with the approval of the Council, at the first regular meeting of the governing body in **July** of every year following an election, the following named officers, who shall hold their offices for a period of two years:

Section 2-1(A)(8) of the Worland City Code shall be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: Section 2-2(B) of the Worland City Code pertaining to the salaries of the Mayor and Council Members shall be amended as follows, to-wit (Amendments in **BOLD**):

Sec. 2-2. Continuation of duties generally; salaries

B. The salaries of the Mayor and Council Members are hereby established as follows:

1. The Mayor shall receive a salary of **\$1,500.00** per month; and

2. Each Council Member shall receive a salary of **\$100.00** per meeting for actual attendance at each regular or special meeting of the governing body and all meetings called by the Mayor and/or President of the Council for official business.

SECTION 3: Section 2-2(C) of the Worland City Code shall be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 4: Section 2-3 of the Worland City Code shall be amended by replacing the words "Police Justice" with the words "**Municipal Judge.**" Further, the last sentence stating "He shall also attend all public assemblies for which licenses or permits have been granted under this Code or the ordinances of the City and perform such other duties as required of the Chief of Police or Marshal by state law" shall be and is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: Section 2-5 of the Worland City Code addressing termination of employees, shall be and is hereby repealed in its

entirety. The termination of employees is addressed in the City Personnel Policy Manual.

SECTION 6: Section 2-6 of the Worland City Code addressing "responsibility of permittees for maintenance of the airport" shall be and is hereby repealed in its entirety. This responsibility will be addressed in Section 2A of the Worland City Code regulating the airport.

SECTION 7: Section 2-7 of the Worland City Code shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit (Amendment in **BOLD**):

The regular meetings of the governing body of the City of Worland shall be held on the first and third Tuesdays of each month in the City Hall commencing at **6:00 p.m.**

SECTION 8: Section 2-8(A) of the Worland City Code shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit (Amendment in **BOLD**):

a. All ordinances and all resolutions shall be presented to the Council in **written format** and shall be read **by title only unless otherwise required by law to be read in full.**

SECTION 9: Section 2-9 of the Worland City Code shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit (Amendments in **BOLD**):

An ordinance, unless otherwise expressly provided therein, **and after having been published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation,** shall not go into effect until **ten (10)** days after the date of its passage.

SECTION 10: Sections 2-11 through 2-23, excepting amended Sections 2-11 and 2-18, of Article III. "Revolving Local Improvement Fund" of the Worland City Code shall be repealed in their entirety. Section 2-11 shall be amended to reads as follows:

Sec. 2-11. Created.

A "revolving local improvement fund" **and all matters pertaining thereto,** as authorized by **Wyoming Statutes 15-6-101 through 15-6-609,** shall be and the same are hereby created.

Section 2-18, Collection of taxes; designation of deposit ories, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit (Amendments in **BOLD**):

Sec. 2-12. Collection of taxes; designation of depositories.

The City, through its duly authorized officials, shall promptly collect and receive the taxes. The portion of monies so collected in the fund shall constitute a trust fund and shall be deposited in **the duly designated Official Depository Banks for the City of Worland, which shall be appointed as depositories annually during the first regular meeting of each year, or as soon as practical thereafter.**

SECTION 11: Section 2-26 of the Worland City Code shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit (Amendments in **BOLD**):

In addition to the powers, duties and responsibilities of the Board of Adjustment and Planning Commission provided for in Chapter 24 of this Code as amended, such commission shall also have all of the powers, duties and responsibilities of a Planning Commission as set forth under the provisions of **Wyoming Statutes Sections 15-1-501 through 15-1-512 (Planning), and Sections 15-1-601 through 15-1-611 (Zoning)**, which are hereby adopted by reference.

SECTION 12: Article V. of Chapter 2 (Disaster and Civil Defense Emergency Management) of the Worland City Code shall be and is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following Article V., to-wit:

ARTICLE V. DISASTER AND CIVIL DEFENSE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Sec. 2-31. Organization and Coordination.

The City of Worland, through its Mayor, Elected Officials, Appointed Officers and authorized employees, will organize and coordinate with the Washakie County Board of Commissioners, the State of Wyoming and in conjunction with the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security, to address situations constituting the management of an emergency, pursuant to the Wyoming Homeland Security Act, as addressed in Wyoming Statutes Section 19-13-101, et seq.

Sec. 2-32. Emergency Management Situations Defined.

Emergency Management Situations constitute those situations specifically described in Wyoming Statutes Section 19-13-102(a)(ii) and in Chapter 13 of said Section, in general.

SECTION 13: If any portion of this ordinance is held or found to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 14: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Worland in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 15: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect on **APRIL 12, 2025**, after having been published in the Northern Wyoming News.
