ORDINANCE NO. 879

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 4-25 OF THE WORLAND CITY CODE PERTAINING TO THE IMPOUNDING OF DOGS THAT HAVE BITTEN PERSONS WITHIN THE CITY OF WORLAND. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WORLAND, WASHAKIE COUNTY, WYOMING.

<u>SECTION 1</u>: Section 4-25 of the Worland City Code shall be amended and supplemented as follows, to-wit (Amendments and Supplements in BOLD):

Sec. 4-25. Confinement of dogs that have bitten persons.

Any dog that has bitten any person shall be confined under the observation of a licensed veterinarian for a period of ten (10) days, after the attack, at the expense of the owner, to determine whether the animal has any disease which may be communicated to humans. Home quarantine may be allowed, as determined by and at the discretion of the Animal Control Officer or Peace Officer.

SECTION 2: If any portion of this ordinance is held or found to be invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Worland in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

 $\underline{\textbf{SECTION 4}}\colon$ This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect on MAY 17, 2025, after having been published in the Northern Wyoming News.
