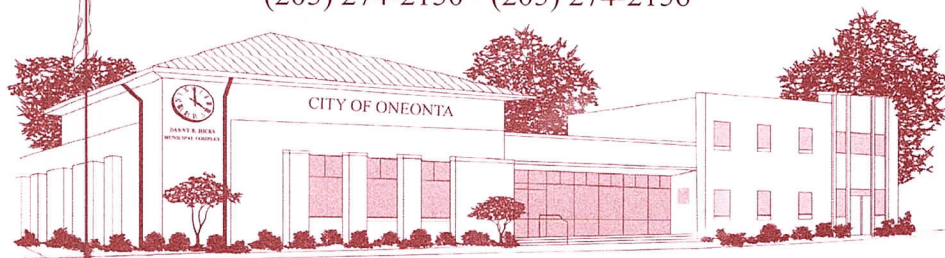

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-6-9

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING ROTATION WRECKER OR TOWING SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Oneonta City Council met on June 9, 2020, and, voted unanimously to amend Section 11. Operation of Rotation System of the Ordinance Regulating Rotation Wrecker or Towing Service as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Oneonta, that the Ordinance Regulating Rotation Wrecker or Towing Service for the City of Oneonta, Alabama, is amended to add as follows:

1. "Section 11. Operation of Rotation System.

C. There shall be an exemption for a heavy duty wrecker company maintaining a local storage lot or a primary place of business within the Oneonta police jurisdiction. Section 11. A. (2) and (5) currently require that an applicant for rotation service pursuant to this ordinance shall maintain a storage lot and a primary place of business within the police jurisdiction for the City of Oneonta. The purpose of this subsection is to exempt from the requirements of those subsections any heavy duty wrecker company which obtains a business license for operation within the City of Oneonta. Certain accidents or vehicle-related incidents demand a wrecker service that exceeds the capabilities of a standard rotation wrecker service. The standard wrecker services utilized by the City of Oneonta employ light duty and medium duty wreckers used in typical non-commercial vehicle accidents or incidents. These previously described wrecker services have been approved and are on a call rotation schedule for the Oneonta Police Department. A wrecker company applying for a business license that utilizes and maintains a heavy-duty wrecker, rotator, or semi-truck Landoll trailer may be allowed to conduct services within the City of Oneonta on an as-needed basis, but shall be exempt from requirements of subsection A.(2) and A. (5) of this

Ordinance. These heavy duty wrecker companies would only be used when there is an accident or motor vehicle incident requiring a heavy duty wrecker, rotator or semi-truck Landoll trailer to clear the scene.


2. The above Section is codified in the Oneonta City Code as SEC. 23-201-Operation of Rotation System C.

3. All other terms and condition of the subject Ordinance not modified herein remain in full force and effect.


