

ORDINANCE 701

BY BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE TOWN OF DELHI
STATE OF LOUISIANA, PARISH OF RICHLAND

At the May 8, 2017 regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Delhi, held at City Hall in the Town of Delhi, Louisiana, Parish of Richland, at which a quorum of the Aldermen was present, the following business was conducted.

ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF DELHI MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN TO ESTABLISH AND AMEND THE DELHI MUNICIPAL CODE as follows:

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2017, the Town of Delhi adopted Ordinance 701:

2.08-.030 The Town of Delhi hereby prohibits the private use of Town of Delhi Police Department vehicles and uniforms while off duty and the Town of Delhi police officers are engaged in any private security or similar work.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Town of Delhi Board of Aldermen do hereby establish the Delhi Municipal Code paragraph 2.08-.030 concerning the Private Use of Public Vehicles and Uniforms,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the following ordinance was read in full, and the ordinance was adopted by a unanimous vote of the Board of Aldermen.
