AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKALOOSA **COUNTY; REPEALING ORDINANCE 80-18** AS AMENDED AND CODIFIED AS APPENDIX D -SPECIAL DISTRICTS, **ARTICLE VII, IN ITS ENTIRETY RELATING** TO THE **KELL-AIRE** GARDENS **SUBDIVISION** MUNICIPAL SERVICES **TAXING UNIT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE** DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 80-18 on June 10, 1980 creating the Kell-Aire Gardens Subdivision Municipal Service Taxing Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Service Taxing Unit was created to provide essential infrastructure within the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, that the Municipal Service Taxing Unit was able to attain its goals and the satisfaction its purpose and is currently been annexed into the municipal boundaries of the City of Destin; and

WHEREAS, that on October 4, 1983, the Board of County Commissioner in regular session approved disbursement of the remaining funds from the Special Assessment Fund to the properties in the Kell-Aire Garden Subdivision Municipal Services Taxing Unit representing their shares of the balance in the Special Assessment Fund; and

WHEREAS, though the purpose of the Municipal Services Taxing Unit have been achieved and the surplus funds returned to the property owners, the formal repeal of the Unit has not occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Okaloosa County:

**SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT**. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into this Ordinance and are adopted as Findings of Fact.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF PROVISION. Ordinance 80-18, as amended, as codified as Appendix D – Special Districts, Article VII, Sections 1 through 18, inclusive, is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be filed with the Secretary State within ten (10) days of adoption and shall become effective upon filing.
