PARISH OF ST. HELENA ORDINANCE #_293_ MOBILE HOME/MANUFACTURED BUILDING MOVING AND PLACEMENT PERMITS

<u>Section 1: Purpose:</u> In order to ensure safe and orderly development and to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens, to ensure against encroachment on other people's property, and to protect property values, the St. Helena Parish Police Jury (the **Parish or Police Jury**) hereby enacts this ordinance through the proper act of its legislative body, the St. Helena Parish Police Jury.

<u>Definitions:</u> For the purposes of this Ordinance, a manufactured home, or mobile home or house trailer, is defined as a vehicle or portable building which is constructed on a chassis, and/or which may be attached to wheels, and which is designed to be towed over roads and highways and to be used for occupancy (residential or business purposes). It may be used with or without a permanent foundation and may be designed to be transported and used in one or more sections. As such, the mobile unit will be duly titled by the appropriate regulatory agency and if rendered unsuitable for transportation, or its title rescinded, shall not be considered a legal mobile home or manufactured home for occupancy in St. Helena Parish. Travel trailers, pick-up campers, motor homes, tent campers, bus trailers, and other such units intended to be used for long term occupancy are included in this definition and must be permitted by the Parish.

Manufactured modular units built off site and intended for occupancy in St. Helena Parish are also included in this definition and shall be permitted by the Parish before movement and occupancy within unincorporated St. Helena Parish.

<u>Section 2: Permit Types:</u> Within the boundaries of the Parish of St. Helena, not including the area within the incorporated municipalities, and from the date of enactment of this ordinance, a mobile home or manufactured home permit for residential or commercial occupancy or placement within the Parish is required. This includes temporary or permanent types of uses for non-site built housing or business manufactured units built off-site and buildings usually not considered mobile units that are moved into or within St. Helena Parish and intended for placement and occupancy. A permit must be obtained from the Parish Building Permit office before any of the following activities, construction, or actions commence within the Parish. These required permits are outlined below:

 Placement and/or renovation of an existing building, manufactured housing, trailer, or mobile home being moved from one location to another location within St.
 Helena Parish or being brought in from outside the Parish for placement and occupancy within St. Helena Parish's unincorporated area.

- Occupancy permit from the Parish of St. Helena for occupancy of new mobile home or manufactured housing structures, whether commercial or residential.
- Moving and placement of new or used mobile homes or modular buildings, manufactured home, modular home, travel trailers, or mobile commercial building intended for occupancy or storage. Only approved and properly skirted HUD standard mobile homes manufactured after July 1st, 1994 (HUD mobile home code date) and having the required and exterior affixed red metal ID label and proper ownership documentation shall be permitted to be placed within the Parish boundaries. Those units located in the Parish not meeting these standards at the time of enactment of this ordinance are allowed to remain (are grandfathered as non-conforming) but shall only be replaced by HUD standard conforming units and may not be relocated within the Parish boundaries unless they are conforming structures properly permitted by the Parish and meeting the 1994 manufactured date shown herein.

Section 3: Permit Process- Start and Expiration Dates: Each application for permits for newly moved structures, intended for occupancy, including mobile or manufactured homes, modular homes, or commercial units, shall first be reviewed for approval by the St. Helena Parish Police Jury. The permit applicant must receive a permit before moving and occupying the manufactured unit. In the case of a mobile home/manufactured home legally permitted to be placed in St. Helena, proper anchoring and complete perimeter skirting must be completed before such mobile home is occupied and shall be completed before occupancy. After receipt of the proper permit, the moving and proper installation of the portable building must begin and be completed within 60 days. After such date, the permit must be updated by the applicant and approved by the Parish Building Permit office.

Section 4: Permit Fees: All moving, placement and occupancy permits to be obtained from the Parish Police Jury in conformance with this ordinance must pay the required permit fee for activities included herein, and such shall be obtained from the St. Helena Parish Building Permit office before commencement of the activity, installation, placement, occupancy, or construction. The fees include a \$200 inspection fee, \$25 sewerage fee, \$25 building-occupancy fee, and \$35 elevation certificate. A site drawing and/or property survey is required from the land owner or permit applicant by the Parish Health Unit in order to specify the location of building placement on the property.

<u>Section 5: Minimum Building Setbacks and Lot Size:</u> The minimum set-backs for newly newly placed mobile homes or buildings defined herein, will be as follows:

- 25 feet minimum front setback from a right of way or property line for residential or commercial buildings
- 25 feet minimum side and rear setbacks from right of way or property line for residential or commercial buildings

- A minimum of 25 feet between building structures on a single lot of record where there
 is no property line or right of way between such buildings
- No building will be located, in whole or in part, within or across private or public servitudes, easements, or rights of way.

Section 6: Minimum Lot Size and Lot Width for placement of a mobile home or manufactured home, or a newly moved building, and not within an approved mobile home park in St. Helena Parish, shall meet minimum Parish and State health and building codes. The required lot size is approximately ½ acre, or 22,500 square feet, per living unit for such units not connecting to approved community sewerage systems and to be served by individual sewage treatment systems. If the unit being placed is to be on property or a site already occupied by another living unit (house, apartment, mobile home, or business), then there will be at least 22,500 square feet on such property or site per living unit located or to be located on such property.

Section 7: Enforcement: The St. Helena Parish Police Jury Building Department, or the St. Helena Police Jury's designated representative, and/or the St. Helena Parish Sherriff's Office, will have the right and obligation to enforce this ordinance. The Parish may issue "stop work" orders to unpermitted or improperly permitted activity and can order that such activity be removed or deconstructed if not properly permitted by the Parish. When installation, placement, or construction activity takes place without a permit, but is allowed to remain, the responsible party must still apply for and obtain a permit after the fact (late fee), which will cost double the permit fees if not obtained before such installation or work begins. The Parish may also choose to deny electrical service, water service, gas service, or other public service or utility connections to any party violating this ordinance. Water Districts or private water companies within St. Helena Parish shall not provide water service to unapproved or unpermitted mobile homes, manufactured or modular homes defined herein without first verifying that such units have received proper permits from the Police Jury. To further enforce this ordinance, a fine of not more than \$500.00 may be charged by the Parish to any property owner, contractor, moving company, builder, agent, or resident that refuses to comply with the required permit outlined in this Ordinance.
