

ORDINANCE NO. 1623

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO
ALLIED WASTE SERVICES
TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL
OR RECYCLING OF PAPER, PLASTIC, CANS, GARBAGE,
TRASH, AND OTHER SOLID WASTE FROM
RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES IN
THE CITY OF GULF SHORES; AND AUTHORIZING
THE EXECUTION OF A FRANCHISE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF GULF SHORES AND THE CORPORATION

WHEREAS, Allied Waste Services has requested a franchise to empower the Corporation to provide for collection and disposal or recycling from residential properties; and

WHEREAS, The City is desirous of granting a nonexclusive franchise to Allied Waste Services to provide such service; and

WHEREAS, The residents of the City will be benefited by the granting of such a franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN RESCHEDULED REGULAR SESSION ON DECEMBER 6, 2010, as follows:

Section 1. That a nonexclusive franchise be and it is hereby granted to Allied Waste Services, a corporation, for collection and disposal or recycling of paper, plastic, cans, garbage, trash, and other solid waste generated in public places or private residential premises within the corporate limits of the City.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby directed and authorized to execute and attest, respectively, a Franchise Agreement between the City of Gulf Shores and Allied Waste Services which sets forth the requirements, covenants and agreements of a franchise to the Corporation for such services.

Section 3. That a copy of the subject Franchise Agreement, marked Exhibit A, is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
