AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 6 – BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KIRKSVILLE MISSOURI TO ALLOW THE PLACEMENT OF MINI-HOUSES IN MOBILE HOME PARKS.

WHEREAS, Mobile Home Park owner Doyle Dover requested approval for a variance to allow the placement of "Mini-Houses" in mobile home parks in the City of Kirksville to fill a void in the need for lower cost housing options in the City; and

WHEREAS, Mini-Houses could be smaller than 750 square feet for a single family home which is not allowed by City Code; and

WHEREAS, these Mini-Houses would still require a building permit and would have to be constructed by a licensed contractor, inspected and approved by City Codes Department before occupancy; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on July 8, 2015 before the Planning and Zoning Commission at which no persons spoke in opposition of this request; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration the Planning and Zoning Commission voted to recommend a change in City Code to allow the placement of Mini-Houses in any mobile home park requesting specific requirements be incorporated into the Code for the placement of Mini-Houses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKSVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section1.</u> That Section 6-87 of Chapter 6, Article VI. One- and Two- Family Dwelling Code be amended establishing requirements for the placement of Mini-Houses in Mobile Home Parks.

That subsection (h) be added to Chapter 6 - Buildings and Building Regulations, Article VI One- and Two-Family Dwelling Code, Sec. 6-87 Amendments as follows:

(h) Mini-House Requirements

1) The placement of mini-houses in the City of Kirksville requires that the structure be constructed within the city limits of Kirksville therefore requiring a building permit allowing for the inspection of such home, and the issuance of a final occupancy permit. Placement within a Mobile Home Park shall follow the requirements as set forth in Article III. Manufactured Homes of the Code of Ordinances, Sec. 13-41 Placement permit required, along with the following:

- a) Habitable space must not be less than 400 square feet.
- b) Must be no less than fourteen feet (14') fire separation between adjacent housing structures.
- c) Each structure must have two off-street hard-surfaced parking spaces designated for that lot of the mobile home park.
- d) Footings, foundation, piers, or concrete slab required.
- e) All structures must have a peaked roof design with gable ends.
- f) Requirements for securing, skirting, utilities and addressing shall follow the requirements outlined in Section 13-42 Manufactured home minimum occupancy requirements.
- g) Relocation of a mini-home from one mobile home park to another mobile home park within the city limits must adhere to Section 13-41. Placement permit required.

This ordinance shall be of full force and effect on the day of passage.
