

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 04

COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR, MICHIGAN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALGONAC, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MICHIGAN TO AMEND CHAPTER 44 "UTILITIES," ARTICLE III "SEWER," DIVISION 1 "GENERALLY," BY REVISING SECTION 68 "AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS" IN ITS ENTIRETY.

THE CITY OF ALGONAC ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.

Chapter 44, Article III, Division 1 is hereby amended to revise Section 68 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 44. – UTILITIES.

ARTICLE III. – SEWER.

DIVISION 1. – GENERALLY.

Sec. 44-68. - Authority to establish rules and regulations.

Under the provisions of the contract, the City is charged with the duty of operating and maintaining the sewer system as the agent of, for, and on behalf of the County, and establishing necessary rules and regulations relative to its use and connections thereto, subject to the approval of the St. Clair County Department of Public Works. The City will by appropriate resolution or ordinance adopt and place into effect such rules, regulations, and standards necessary to ensure the proper operation and maintenance of the sewer system in accordance with the recommendations of, and subject to the approval of, the St. Clair County Department of Public Works. The City will further adopt such rules, regulations, and standards concerning connections to and use of the sewer system necessary to meet both public health requirements and the recommendations of the St. Clair County Department of Public Works, including adequate and lawful penalties for violations of any of such rules, regulations, and standards.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

This ordinance and each of the various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases, and clauses hereof are declared to be severable. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Any and all Ordinances of the City of Algonac or any parts or provisions thereof, to the extent that they are contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of the within Ordinance, are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. RATIFICATION

All other provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Algonac, Michigan except as herein modified or amended are hereby expressly ratified and affirmed.


SECTION 5. PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance shall take immediate effect upon publication in accordance with the provisions and requirements of the City Charter of the City of Algonac.
