

ORDINANCE NO. 2926

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GILBERT, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CODE OF GILBERT, ARIZONA, CHAPTER 62 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, SECTION 62-67 NO PARKING AREAS; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the Town of Gilbert, Arizona, as follows:

Section I. In General.

The Code of Gilbert, Arizona, CHAPTER 62 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, SECTION 62-67 NO PARKING AREAS is hereby amended to read as follows (additions in ALL CAPS and UNDERLINE; deletions in ~~strikeout~~):

Sec. 62-67. No parking areas.

- (a) In addition to the parking restrictions set forth in A.R.S. § 28-873, no person shall park a vehicle in any of the following places:
- (1) So as to block or obstruct any alleyway.
 - (2) Upon or in front of another person's private road or driveway.
 - (3) Upon any area, parking lot, roadway, or portion thereof, whether public or private property, designated as a fire lane by the traffic engineer.
 - (4) On a sidewalk.
 - (5) Within an intersection.
 - (6) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
 - (7) On a crosswalk.
 - (8) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.
 - (9) Within 30 feet on the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, yield sign or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway.
 - (10) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone.
 - (11) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail or railroad crossing or within eight feet six inches of the center of any railroad track, except while a motor vehicle with a motive power attached is loading or unloading railroad cars.

- (12) Within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to a fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within 75 feet of the entrance when properly posted.
 - (13) Alongside or opposite a street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic.
 - (14) On the roadway side of a vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street.
 - (15) On a bridge or other elevated structure on a highway or within a highway tunnel.
 - (16) At any place where official signs prohibit standing or stopping.
 - (17) OVER, ON, OR COVERING ANY MARKINGS OF ANY PARKING SPACES, PARKING STALLS, OR PARKING AREAS, UNLESS SUCH VEHICLE'S SIZE PROHIBITS IT FROM PARKING WITHIN A SINGLE PARKING SPACE, PARKING STALL, OR PARKING AREA, OR EXCEPT AS PART OF A TOWN-APPROVED SPECIAL EVENT OR ANY OTHER EVENT SPONSORED BY OR APPROVED BY THE TOWN OF GILBERT. IF SUCH VEHICLE'S SIZE PROHIBITS IT FROM PARKING WITHIN A SINGLE PARKING SPACE, PARKING STALL, OR PARKING AREA, IT SHALL BE PARKED WITHIN THE FEWEST PRACTICABLE PARKING SPACES, PARKING STALLS, OR PARKING AREAS TO FIT SUCH VEHICLE.
- (b) Any vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of this article may be moved by and under direction of an officer, and at the expense of the owner, into a place where parking is permitted.
 - (c) The stopping, standing or parking restrictions provided in this section do not apply to a police or peace officer when the stopping, standing or parking is for the purpose of actual performance of a law enforcement duty.

Section II. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.


All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.


