

ORDINANCE NO. 2927

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GILBERT, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CODE OF GILBERT, ARIZONA, CHAPTER 62 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, SECTION 62-70 ANGLE PARKING; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the Town of Gilbert, Arizona, as follows:

Section I. In General.

The Code of Gilbert, Arizona, CHAPTER 62 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, SECTION 62-70 ANGLE PARKING is hereby amended to read as follows (additions in ALL CAPS and UNDERLINE; deletions in ~~strikeout~~):

Sec. 62-70. Angle Parking.

The traffic engineer, with council approval, shall determine upon what streets angle parking shall be permitted and shall mark ~~or sign~~ such streets. Such angle parking shall not be indicated upon a federal aid or state highway within the town unless the state department of transportation has determined that the roadway is of sufficient width to permit angle parking without interfering with the free movement of traffic.

Section II. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.






