

ORDINANCE C-5-2018

**CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FARMINGTON HILLS CITY CODE BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE IV, "BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COUNCILS," DIVISION 8, "FARMINGTON AREA ARTS COMMISSION," SECTION 2-222, "PURPOSE" TO UPDATE THE PURPOSE OF THE COMMISSION, AND DIVISION 9, "COMMISSION ON VOTER PARTICIPATION" TO CORRECT THE COMMISSION NAME.

THE CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1 of Ordinance. Ordinance Amendment.

The Farmington Hills City Code, Chapter 2, "Administration," Article IV, "Boards, Commissions and Councils," Division 8, "Farmington Area Arts Commission," Section 2-222, "Purposes, authority and duties," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-222. – Purposes, authorities and duties.

The FAAC is charged with the authority and responsibility of supporting the cities of Farmington and Farmington Hills in efforts to ensure the arts and cultural heritage are integral components of daily life in our communities. FAAC is committed to arts advocacy by serving as a conduit between local government and arts organizations, artists, educators, and the community at large.

Section 2 of Ordinance. Ordinance Amendment.

The Farmington Hills City Code, Chapter 2, "Administration," Article IV, "Boards, Commissions and Councils," Division 9, "Commission to Increase Voter Participation," is hereby amended to read as follows:

DIVISION 9. - COMMITTEE TO INCREASE VOTER PARTICIPATION

Sec. 2-231. - Establishment; purposes.

The City of Farmington Hills established the committee to increase voter participation by motion of the city council on April 26, 1976. The city hereby ratifies and continues the existence of this committee under this Code as a duly organized and established city commission having the name committee to increase voter participation and the purposes set forth below.

Sec. 2-232. - Authority, purposes and duties.

The committee to increase voter participation is charged with the purposes, authority and duties of stimulating and improving voter participation in all elections and increasing the quality and quantity of publicity and information regarding such elections.

Sec. 2-233. - Members.

The committee to increase voter participation shall consist of eleven (11) regular members and two (2) alternate members, who shall represent, insofar as possible, the residents of the city and businesses located within the city.

Sec. 2-234. - Other applicable ordinances.

Without limitation, refer to chapter 2, article IV, division 1 of this Code for additional city ordinances that may be applicable to the committee.

Section 3 of the Ordinance. Repealer.

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or sections of the City Code in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect and the Farmington Hills Ordinance Code shall remain in full force and effect amended only as specified above.

Section 4 of the Ordinance. Severability.

If any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, void, illegal or ineffective by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or in part, shall not be affected other than the part invalidated, and such section, clause or provision declared to be unconstitutional, void or illegal shall thereby cease to be a part of this Ordinance, but the remainder of this Ordinance shall stand and be in full force and effect.

Section 5 of the Ordinance. Savings.

The amendment of the Farmington Hills Code of Ordinances set forth in this Ordinance does not affect or impair any act done, offense committed, or right accruing, accrued, or acquired or liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment, pending or incurred prior to the amendment of the Farmington Hills Code of Ordinances set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 6 of the Ordinance. Effective Date.

The provisions of this Ordinance are ordered to take effect twenty-one (21) days after enactment.

Section 7 of the Ordinance. Enactment.

This Ordinance is declared to have been enacted by the City Council of the City of Farmington Hills at a meeting called and held on the 13th day of August, 2018 and ordered to be given publication in the manner prescribed by law.
