

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-4190

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PRIOR ORDINANCES OF
THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE CODE OF ORDINANCES
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING CHARGES OR
RATES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES OF THE COMBINED
WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE
OF ROSELLE, DUPAGE AND COOK COUNTIES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, provides for the operation of a Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System in the Village and has heretofore established charges or rates for the use and service of said Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System; and

WHEREAS, said charges and rates have been set forth in ordinances dating from 1925, the most recent ordinance being Ordinance No. 2019-4072 passed December 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed necessary and appropriate to amend said ordinance to change the rates that the Village charges the users of the Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 22-22, titled “Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System Rates and Charges,” and Section 22-143, titled “User charges,” of Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Roselle, and any and all combined waterworks and sewerage system rates set forth in all prior ordinances of the Village, are hereby repealed and rescinded in their entirety effective January 1, 2022 and replaced effective January 1, 2022 with the following:

Sec. 22-22. **Combined waterworks and sewerage system rates and charges.**

Effective for bills issued on or after January 1, 2022, rates and charges for the use of and for the services supplied by the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village of Roselle, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, based upon the amount of water consumed as shown by the water meter, shall be as follows:

- (1) Within the corporate limits of the Village:
 - a) Water rates for each residential, apartment, commercial, or industrial user of the combined system within the corporate limits shall be: \$8.45 per 1,000 gallons, per monthly billing period. The minimum monthly charge for water service only shall be \$8.45 per monthly billing period.
 - b) The capital improvement surcharge for each residential, apartment, commercial, or industrial user of the combined system within the corporate limits, shall be \$6.00 per 1,000 gallons, per monthly billing period. The minimum monthly charge for the capital improvement surcharge shall be \$6.00 per monthly billing period.
- (2) Outside the corporate limits of the Village;
 - (a) Users connected to the Roselle Water System outside the corporate limits of the Village shall pay water rates and capital improvement surcharges for such connection and service supplied in a sum equal to 1 ½ times the rates and capital improvement surcharges applicable within the corporate limits of the Village.
 - (b) Users of the system who have only a sewerage system connection shall pay the rate specified in Sec. 22-143(2) and (3) of this Ordinance.

Sec. 22-143. User Charges.

Effective for bills issued on or after January 1, 2022 basic user rates for the use of, and service supplied by, the wastewater facilities of the Village within the Village limits based on the amount of water consumed, as shown by the water meter shall be as follows:

- (1) A basic user rate per thousand gallons shall be applied to all domestic water discharges based as follows:

DuPage County

\$6.25/1,000 gallons

Cook County

\$3.35/1,000 gallons *

*Users of the Cook County system pay for use of and for service by the MWROGC wastewater facilities through property taxes.

- (2) All non-metered users of the wastewater facilities shall pay a minimum monthly flat rate charge adequate to cover the cost of the debt service charge and the basic user rate. The flat rate is based upon average residential monthly water consumption as follows:

DuPage County

$\$6.25/1,000 \text{ gallons} \times 6,000 \text{ gallons} = \37.50

Cook County

$\$3.35/1,000 \text{ gallons} \times 6,000 \text{ gallons} = \20.10

In the event that the use of wastewater facilities by a flat-rate user is determined by the Village to probably exceed 6,000 gallons per month, the Village may require such flat-rate user to install water metering devices on the water supply or sewer main to measure the gallons of water used.

- (3) Users of the system who have only a sewerage system connection shall pay flat rates and charges for the capital improvement of the sewerage system in the sum of \$36.00 per monthly billing period. ($\$6.00/1,000 \text{ gallons} \times 6,000 \text{ gallons} = \36.00).

SECTION 2: Until January 1, 2022 the rates for all sewer and water charges shall be those imposed by Ordinance 2019-4072.

SECTION 3: That all the provisions of the ordinances not hereby expressly amended as provided in this amendatory Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect and nothing contained herein shall be construed to repeal any of the above ordinances.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as required by law, and the publication of this Ordinance in pamphlet form is hereby authorized and directed.
