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**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-4373**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
CHAPTER 22 ARTICLE I  
SECTION 22-22 AND SECTION 22-143 OF  
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE VILLAGE OF ROSELLE, ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Roselle (hereinafter referred to as the “Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois;

**WHEREAS**, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of ordinances which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Roselle, as amended;

**WHEREAS**, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents, including the imposition of certain taxes and fees;

**WHEREAS**, the Village provides for the operation of a Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System and has heretofore established charges or rates for the use and service of said Combined Waterworks and Sewerage System;

**WHEREAS**, the Village desires to amend its code of ordinances providing for an increase to certain user fees and charges in order to offset increasing operational expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Roselle are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the residents to amend the village’s code of ordinances as referenced herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, in open meeting assembled, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois as follows:

**Section One - Recitals**

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section Two – Amendment to Chapter 22 Article I Section 22-22**

Chapter 22 Article I Section 22-22 shall be amended as follows (additions appearing underlined and any deleted language appearing with a ~~strike-through~~ line):

- (1) Within the corporate limits of the village:
  - a. Water rates for each residential, apartment, commercial, or industrial user of the combined system within the corporate limits shall be: \$9.25-9.75 per 1,000 gallons, per monthly billing period. The minimum monthly charge for water service only

shall be ~~\$9.25~~ 9.75 per monthly billing period.

- b. The capital improvement surcharge for each residential, apartment, commercial, or industrial user of the combined system within the corporate limits, shall be ~~\$7.50~~ 8.00 per 1,000 gallons, per monthly billing period. The minimum monthly charge for the capital improvement surcharge shall be ~~\$7.50~~ 8.00 per monthly billing period.

### Section Three – Amendment to Chapter 22 Article I Section 22-143

Chapter 22 Article I Section 22-143 shall be amended as follows (additions appearing underlined and any deleted language appearing with a ~~strike-through~~ line):

- (1) A basic user rate per thousand gallons shall be applied to all domestic water discharges based as follows:

DuPage County  
~~\$7.10~~ 7.37/1,000 gallons

Cook County  
~~\$3.55~~ 3.68/1,000 gallons\*

\*Users of the Cook County system pay for use of and for service by the MWROGC wastewater facilities through property taxes.

- (2) All non-metered users of the wastewater facilities shall pay a minimum monthly flat rate charge adequate to cover the cost of the debt service charge and the basic user rate. The flat rate is based upon average residential monthly water consumption as follows:

DuPage County

~~\$7.10~~ 7.37/1,000 gallons x 6,000 gallons = ~~\$42.60~~ 44.22

Cook County

~~\$3.55~~ 3.68/1,000 gallons x 6,000 gallons = ~~\$21.30~~ 22.08

In the event that the use of wastewater facilities by a flat-rate user is determined by the Village to probably exceed 6,000 gallons per month, the Village may require such flat-rate user to install water metering devices on the water supply or sewer main to measure the gallons of water used.

- (3) Users of the system who have only a sewerage system connection shall pay flat rates and charges for the capital improvement of the sewerage system in the sum of ~~\$45.00~~ 48.00 per monthly billing period. (~~\$7.50~~ 8.00/1,000 gallons x 6,000 gallons = ~~\$45.00~~ 48.00).

### Section Four – Codification

The title, chapter(s) and section(s) adopted by this ordinance shall be numbered and placed in an appropriate title, chapter(s), and section(s) when and during the codification of the Roselle Municipal Code.

**Section Five - Conflict Clause**

That all ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

**Section Six - Passage Clause**

That this ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**Section Seven - Constitutionality Clause**

Any part or parts of this ordinance declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or the Roselle Municipal Code.

**Section Seven - Publication**

This ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Section Eight - Recording**

This ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Roselle.
