To amend Chapter 7, Elections, Article II, Election Districts, Division 2, District Boundaries, and Article III, Precincts and Polling Places, Division I, Generally, and Division 2, Precinct Boundaries.

PUBLIC HEARING: March 22, 2022

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the code amendments and recommends approval as stated

in the executive summary dated March 22, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania Board of Supervisors held a public hearing, duly advertised

in a local newspaper for a period of two weeks, on March 8, 2022 and March 15, 2022 and

interested citizens were offered an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the general welfare is served by approval of the code amendments.

§ 1. That Chapter 7, Elections, Article II, Election Districts, Division 2, District

The boundaries of the precincts in the Salem Election District are as follows:

- (1) Battlefield Elementary (601): Beginning at the most northerly point of Battlefield Elementary precinct, thence southeasterly 0.19 miles along Harrison Road, State Route 620; thence southerly 0.33 miles along Old Leavells Road, State Route 1284; thence southerly 0.06 miles to its projected intersection with Leavells Road, State Route 639; thence southeasterly 1.64 miles along Leavells Road, State Route 639; thence westerly 0.87 miles along northern boundary of US Census Block 511770203071014, thence northwesterly 0.74 miles along Massaponax Creek; thence southwesterly 0.86 miles along unnamed tributary to Massaponax Creek, thence southwesterly 0.15 miles along Toney Lane; thence northwesterly 0.71 miles along Smith Station Road, State Route 628; thence northerly 0.43 miles along Piedmont Drive, State Route 673; thence easterly 0.71 miles along unnamed tributary of Massaponax Creek; thence northwesterly 0.42 miles along Massaponax Creek; thence northwesterly 1.12 miles along Piedmont Drive, State Route 673 to the aforementioned point of beginning.
- (2) Smith Station Elementary (602): Beginning at the most northerly point of Smith Station Elementary precinct, thence southeasterly 1.90 miles along Massaponax Creek; thence westerly 0.71 miles along unnamed tributary of Massaponax Creek, thence southerly 0.43 miles along Piedmont Drive, State Route 673; thence northwesterly 1.12 miles along Smith

Station Road, State Route 628; thence northeasterly 1.68 miles along Gordon Road, State Route 627 to the aforementioned point of beginning.

- (3) **Chancellor High** (603): Beginning at the most northerly point of Chancellor High precinct, thence easterly 0.80 miles along Plank Road, State Route 3; thence southerly 0.01 miles along Old Plank Road, State Route 610; thence easterly 0.06 miles along Plank Road, State Route 3; thence southerly 0.61 miles along Cherry Road, State Route 706; thence southeasterly 0.89 miles along Harrison Road, State Route 620; thence southwesterly 1.12 miles along Piedmont Drive, State Route 673; thence northwesterly 1.48 miles along Massaponax Creek; thence northeasterly 0.67 miles along Gordon Road, State Route 627; thence northwesterly 0.50 miles along Harrison Road, State Route 620 to the aforementioned point of beginning.
- (4) Courthouse Road Elementary (604): Beginning at the most northerly point of Courthouse Road Elementary precinct, thence southeasterly 0.74 miles along Massaponax Creek; thence easterly 0.87 miles along the northern boundary of US Census Block 511770203071014; thence southerly 0.79 miles along Leavells Road, State Route 639; thence northwesterly 0.24 miles along Massaponax Creek; thence westerly 1.48 miles along unnamed tributaries of Massaponax Creek; thence southwesterly 0.38 miles along Courthouse Road, State Route 208; thence northerly 0.70 miles along Smith Station Road, State Route 628; thence northeasterly 0.15 miles along Toney Lane; thence northeasterly 0.86 miles along unnamed tributary of Massaponax Creek to the aforementioned point of beginning.
