## ORDINANCE 2015-100-E

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CAR WASH FACILITIES IN CERTAIN COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL ZONING DISTRICTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 656 (ZONING CODE), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), SUBPART B (ADMINISTRATION), SECTION 656.110 (ENFORCEMENT) TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION H TO PROVIDE FOR GRANDFATHERING; PART 3 (SCHEDULE OF DISTRICT REGULATIONS), SUBPART C (COMMERCIAL USE CATEGORIES AND ZONING DISTRICTS), SECTION 656.313 (COMMUNITY/GENERAL COMMERCIAL CATEGORY), ORDINANCE CODE TO ADD AUTOMATED CAR WASH FACILITIES AND MOBILE CAR DETAILING SERVICES AS A PERMITTED USE AND MANUAL CAR WASH FACILITIES AS A PERMISSIBLE USE BY EXCEPTION TO THE LIST OF USES IN THE CCG-1 ZONING DISTRICT; TO DELETE CAR WASH BY EXCEPTION FROM THE LIST OF USES IN THE CCG-1 ZONING DISTRICT; TO ADD AUTOMATED CAR WASH FACILITIES, AUTO LAUNDRY FACILITIES AND MOBILE CAR DETAILING SERVICES AS PERMITTED USES AND MANUAL CAR WASH FACILITIES AS A PERMISSIBLE USE BY EXCEPTION TO THE LIST OF USES IN THE CCG-2 ZONING DISTRICT; TO DELETE CAR WASH FROM THE LIST OF USES IN THE CCG-2 ZONING DISTRICT; AMENDING SUBPART D (INDUSTRIAL USE CATEGORIES AND ZONING DISTRICTS), SECTION 656.322 (LIGHT INDUSTRIAL CATEGORY), ORDINANCE CODE TO ADD

AUTOMATED CAR WASH FACILITIES, AUTO LAUNDRY FACILITIES AND MOBILE CAR DETAILING PERMITTED USES AND MANUAL CAR WASH FACILITIES AS A PERMISSIBLE USE BY EXCEPTION TO THE LIST OF USES IN THE IL ZONING DISTRICT; TO DELETE CAR WASH FROM THE LIST OF USES IN THE IL ZONING DISTRICT; AMENDING SECTION 656.323 (HEAVY INDUSTRIAL CATEGORY), ORDINANCE CODE TO ADD AUTOMATED CAR WASH FACILITIES, LAUNDRY FACILITIES AND MOBILE CAR DETAILING AS PERMITTED USES AND MANUAL CAR WASH FACILITIES AS A PERMISSIBLE USE BY EXCEPTION TO THE LIST OF USES IN THE IH ZONING DISTRICT; PART 16 (DEFINITIONS), SECTION AMENDING 656.1601 (DEFINITIONS), ORDINANCE CODE TO ADD NEW DEFINITIONS FOR AUTO LAUNDRY, AUTOMATED CAR WASH, MANUAL CAR WASH AND MOBILE CAR DETAILING; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, numerous unauthorized car wash activities are operating in Jacksonville without connection to a permanent structure or business operation; and

WHEREAS, such car wash activities are occurring where individuals participate in certain activities having no direct connection to the car wash activities, and may contribute to blight conditions in Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, car wash facilities require compliance with environmental rules and regulations for the proper elimination of wastewater in order to protect the groundwaters of Duval County; and

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WHEREAS, the Special Ad Hoc Committee on Jacksonville's Neighborhood Blight seeks to eliminate such blight conditions which stem from unauthorized car wash activities by regulating car wash facilities in certain commercial and industrial zoning districts; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2015, the members of the Ad Hoc Committee on Blight approved this Ordinance for introduction to the Jacksonville City Council (A copy of the minutes of the January 22, 2015 Committee meeting is attached hereto as Exhibit 1); now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Chapter 656 (Zoning Code), Part 1 (General Provisions), Subpart B (Administration) Section 656.110 (Enforcement), Ordinance Code amended.

Section 656.110 (Enforcement), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 656.110. Enforcement.

The provisions of this Zoning Code shall be enforced as follows:

- (a) By the Director, through the Chief of the Current Planning Division, or his designee, or by the Chief of the Municipal Code Compliance Division; provided, however, that Parts 12 and 13 of this Chapter shall be enforced through the Chief of the Building Inspection Division, or his designee.
- (b) By the Municipal Code Enforcement Board or Special Magistrate pursuant to the authority granted by F.S. Ch. 162, Part I, and Ch. 91, Ordinance Code;

- (c) By the City of Jacksonville through the prosecution of violations in the name of the State of Florida pursuant to F.S. § 166.0415.
- (d) By the Office of General Counsel, at the request of the Chief, the Director (or the Chief of the Building Inspection Division for Parts 12 and 13 of this Chapter), or by the Chief of the Municipal Code Compliance Division or the City Council.
- (e) Nothing contained herein shall be construed to abridge or alter rights of action or remedies in equity, or to estop any person affected by a zoning violation, in the exercise of their rights in equity or under the common law, from suppressing nuisances or abating zoning violations.
- (f) By citation for civil penalties pursuant to the authority granted by F.S. Ch. 162, Part II, and Ch. 609, Ordinance Code or utilizing the notice and citation procedures outlined in Subpart D to Chapter 518; and
- (g) By action for injunctive relief, for civil penalties, or both, through a court of competent jurisdiction.
- (h) Certain Uses grandfathered. Notwithstanding anything in this Chapter to the contrary, those persons holding approved zoning exceptions or any other form of written approval from any person or entity authorized to grant such approval, as determined by the Planning and Development Department on a case-by-case basis, shall be authorized to continue their permitted use in accordance with the terms of their zoning exception or other form of written approval.

Auto Laundry means a full service or self-service automobile washing facility comprised of permanent structural improvements including a combination of wash bays, vacuums, engine cleaning, compressed air supply, window tinting, headliner replacement, upholstery cleaning and repair, and/or automobile related vending machines where all wastewater is managed through a 100% closed-loop recycle system, a Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) permitted partial recycle system, an approved discharge to a municipal sanitary sewer system with pretreatment if required by the utility or is collected and containerized for transport to an FDEP permitted treatment facility.

Automated Car Wash means a completely automated automobile washing facility that is designed and operated as an accessory use to a primary automobile related use or building where all wastewater is managed through a 100% closed loop recycle system for which the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) permit has been approved, an approved discharge to a municipal sanitary sewer system with pretreatment if required by the utility, or is collected and containerized for transport to an FDEP permitted treatment facility.

\* \* \*

Manual Car Wash means a commercial automobile wash facility, either temporary or permanent, where vehicles are primarily washed by hand by individual persons. This definition shall not apply to bona fide automobile dealerships, rental car facilities or to

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temporary one-day fundraising events by civic, religious, or non-profit entities where volunteers wash vehicles by hand, and the number of fundraising events does not exceed six (6) events per year, and the monetary proceeds from which are used to support the activities or mission of the civic, religious or non-profit entity.

\* \* \*

Mining means the process or business of extracting ore, minerals or materials from the earth.

Mobile Car Detailing Services means the performance of thorough cleaning, and restoration of the finish of an automobile, both inside and/or out, to produce a show-quality level of detail where the service provider travels to a location for the purpose of detailing a vehicle(s), and is temporary in nature, and shall not remain at the same location in excess of 48 hours. Such services are prohibited in all residential zoning districts.

Mobile home means a detached single-family dwelling unit with all the following characteristics:

- (a) Designed for long term occupancy, and containing sleeping accommodations, and plumbing and electrical connections provided for attachment to outside systems;
- (b) Designed for transportation after fabrication on streets or highways on its own wheels; and
- (c) Arriving at the site where it is to be occupied as a dwelling complete, including major appliances, and ready for occupancy except for minor and incidental unpacking and assembly operations, located on jacks or other temporary or permanent foundations, and connected to utilities and the like.

A travel trailer is not to be considered as a mobile home.
