

## **BOROUGH OF NAUGATUCK**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Mayor and Burgesses, in a meeting duly assembled on June 7, 2016, that the following ordinance is hereby amended:

### **ORDINANCE #122**

Chapter 10, Article V, Blight and Nuisances, §§ 10-65 – 10-82 of the Code of Ordinances, Borough of Naugatuck, Connecticut, a summary of the amendment is as follows:

- 1) The time period to remedy civil blight violations is reduced from thirty (30) days to fifteen (15) days;
- 2) Section 10-68(7) is amended to include paint chipping/deterioration if in excess of thirty-three percent (33%) of the structure;
- 3) Sections 10-68(6)-(7) are amended, deleting the one (1) year “persistence” requirement to be in violation of a building, fire, housing, or health code; and
- 4) Section 10-78(a) is amended to include criminal penalties for blight violators.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
