

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-O-009

AMENDING CHAPTER 23, PARKS AND LEISURE SERVICES, ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LAREDO TO ALLOW THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE OR REDUCE UNI-TRADE STADIUM RENTAL FEES AS SET OUT IN ORDINANCE 2017-O-135 ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS WHEN IT IS DEEMED IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo is a municipality and owns and operates the Uni-Trade Stadium for the use by and for the benefit of the public; and

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo is committed to providing the Laredo community with access to this facility and events through an affordable and responsible manner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City of Laredo Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Parks and Leisure Services, Article I, In General, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 23-12 Waiver of Uni-Trade Stadium Rental Fees

The City Manager may waive in whole or in part the Turn Key Baseball Fees as provided in 23-6

at the Uni-Trade Stadium on a case by case basis when it is deemed in the best interest of the City.

Section 2: All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

Section 3: It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance, since the same is enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.


Section 4: This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Laredo Texas, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect as and from the date of passage.
