

ORDINANCE No. 2021-02

An Ordinance to Authorize the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages
on Sunday in the City Limits of the City of Clanton, Alabama and to
Amend Ordinance No. 15-87 Section 3-35

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clanton determined it served a public purpose to authorize the sale of alcohol within the Clanton city limits by adopting Ordinance No. 15-87; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clanton has determined it serves a public purpose to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday within the Clanton city limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clanton, Alabama that the Clanton City Council hereby amends Section 3-35 of the City of Clanton Code of Ordinances numbered 15-87 to state the following changes noted in bold:

Section. 3-35 – Hours of sale in lounges, restaurants, etc.

All lounges, clubs, private clubs, restaurants or other places serving alcoholic beverages shall abate the sale of all whiskey, wine, beer or liquor at 2:00 a.m. These businesses may commence the sale of such beverages at 6:00 a.m., except Sunday **[except as provided in subsection (b) below]**. No sales shall be made between 2:00 a.m. Sunday and 6:00 a.m. Monday.

(b) All properly licensed retail licensees of the alcohol beverage control board serving the general public in the city for on-premises and off-premises consumption are authorized to sell alcoholic beverages on *Sundays* between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on Monday.

THEREUPON Billy Singleton, a councilmember, moved and Awlahjaday Agee, a councilmember, seconded the motion that Ordinance No. 2021-02 be given vote. The roll call vote on said motion was as follows:
