

ORDINANCE No. 2021-06

An Ordinance to Authorize the Sale of Alcoholic Draft Beer in the City Limits of the City of Clanton, Alabama

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clanton determined it served a public purpose to authorize the sale of alcohol within the Clanton city limits by adopting Ordinance No. 15-87; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clanton has determined it serves a public purpose to authorize the sale of alcoholic draft beer within the Clanton city limits; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama State Legislature approved local legislation authorizing the sale of alcoholic draft beer in the Clanton city limits; and

WHEREAS, Alabama Governor Kay Ivey signed Act 2021-458 into law on Monday, May 17, 2021 at 1:33 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clanton, Alabama that the Clanton City Council hereby amends Section 3-26 of the City of Clanton Code of Ordinances numbered 15-87 to state the following changes noted in bold:

Section. 3-26 – Definitions (Changes are notated in bold)

Alcoholic beverage means any alcoholic, spirituous, vinous, fermented or other alcoholic beverage, or combination of liquors and mixed liquor, a part of which is spirituous, vinous, fermented or otherwise alcoholic, and all drinks or drinkable liquids, preparations or mixtures intended for beverage purposes, which contain one-half of one percent or more of alcohol by volume, and shall include liquor, beer, **including draft beer**, and wine, both fortified and table wine.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clanton, Alabama that draft beer sales, with the exception of keg beer, shall be authorized under the same alcoholic license as regular beer for both on and off premise use.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clanton, Alabama that Ordinance 2021-06 shall become effective at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 1, 2021; or as required by law.

THEREUPON Billy Singleton, a councilmember, moved and Awlahjaday Agee, a councilmember, seconded the motion that Ordinance No. 2021-06 be given vote. The roll call vote on said motion was as follows:
