

## **ORDINANCE**

The Mayor and Council of the City of Duluth, Georgia hereby ordain that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Duluth is hereby amended by deleting in its entirety Subsection (a) of Section 259 Chapter 3, Article II and replacing said section with the following new subsection (a), Section 259 of Chapter 3, Article II:

Sec. 3-259. - Licensed caterers.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to the contrary, a caterer shall be permitted to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises of a duly authorized catered event, if the caterer is a retailer dealer licensed pursuant to state law and has obtained the following licenses and permits:
  - (1) A license permitting the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises in addition to a alcoholic beverage catering license issued by the city or another licensing jurisdiction, and
  - (2) An off-premises permit for the specific event being catered.
